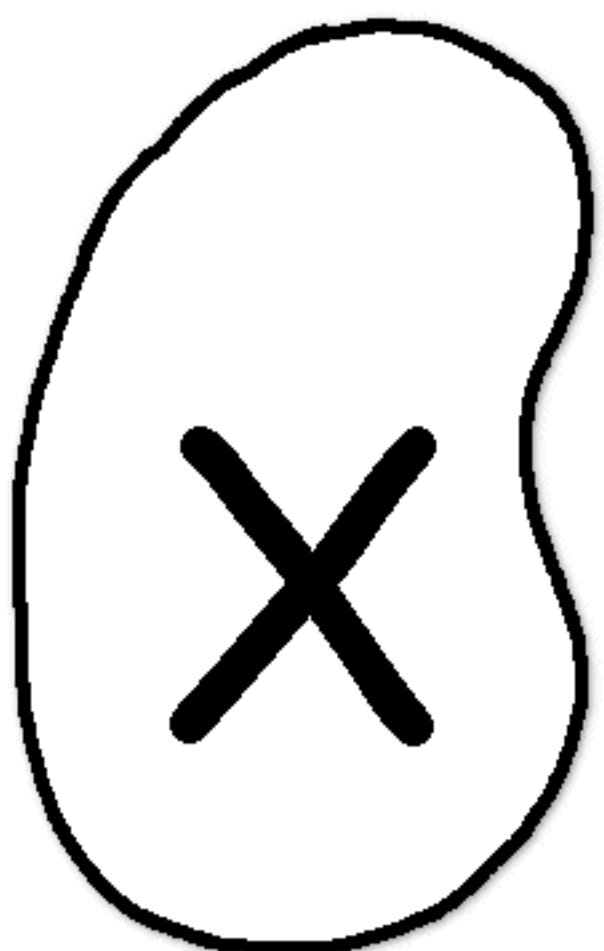
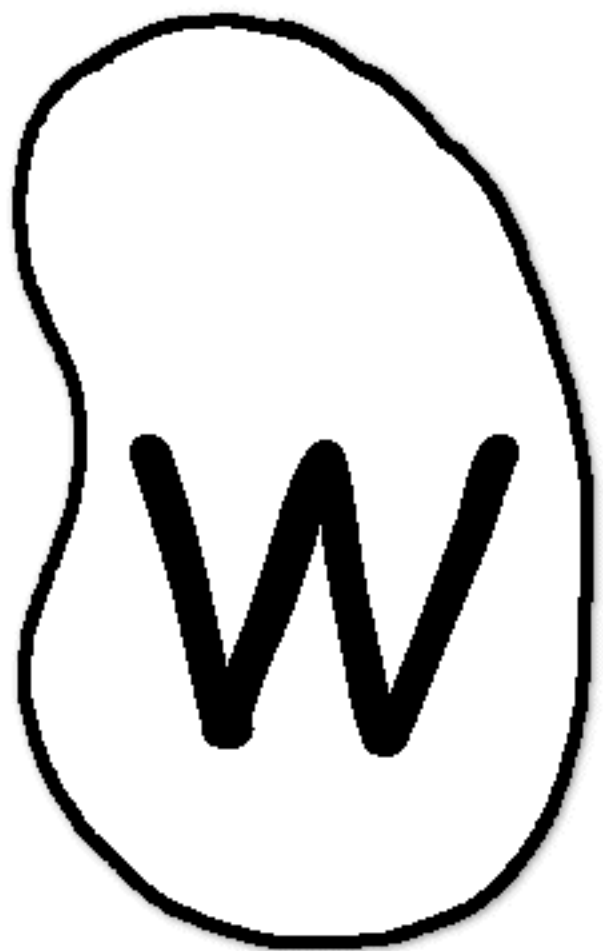
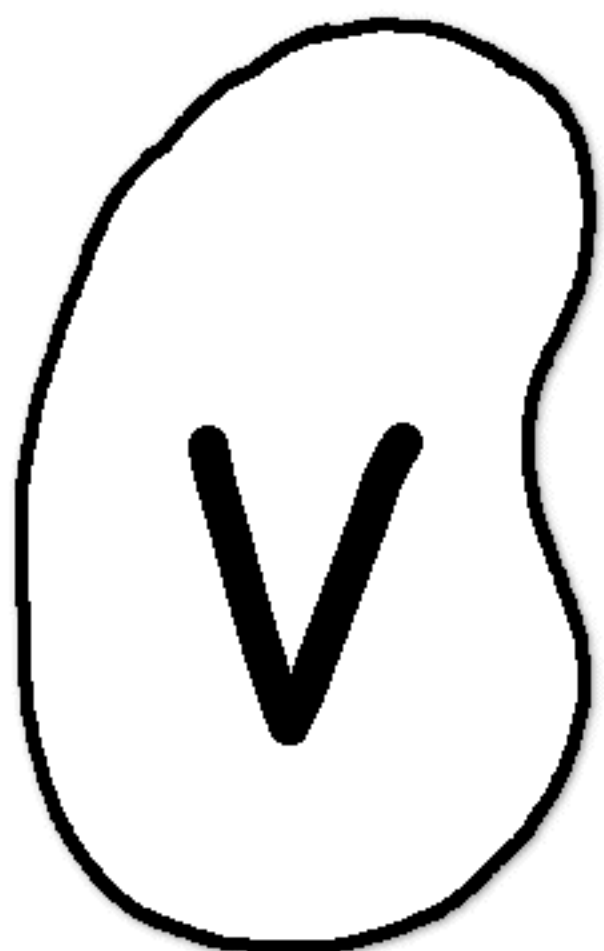
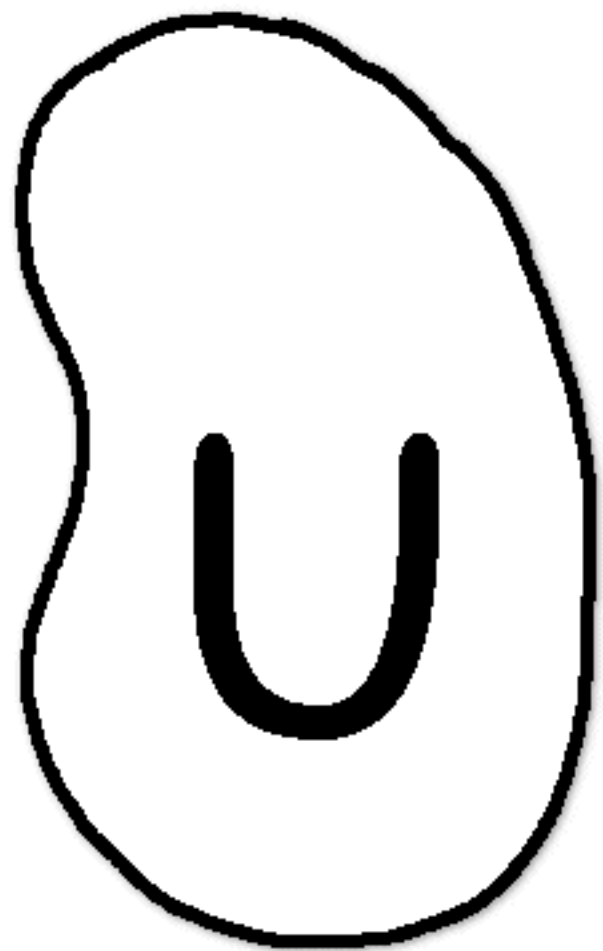


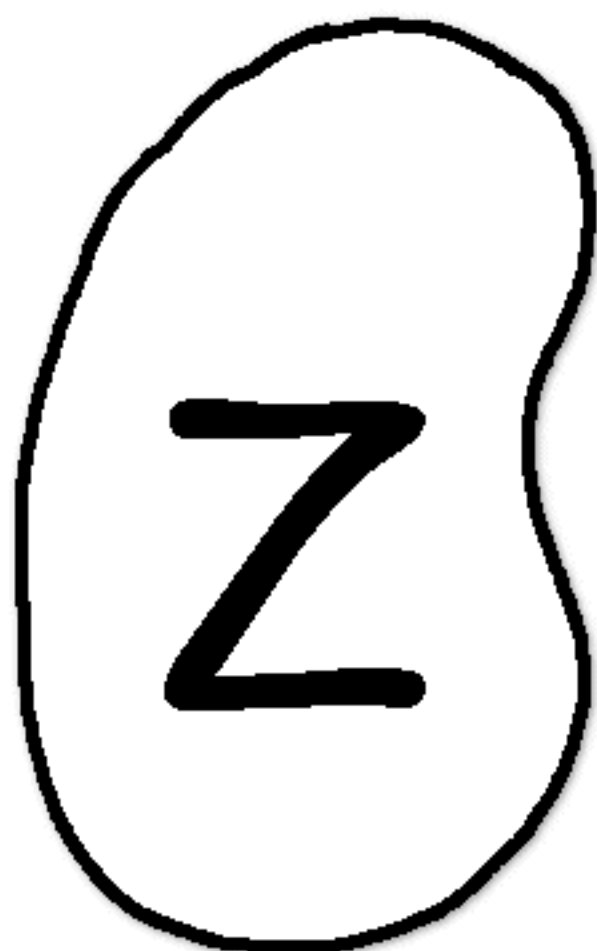
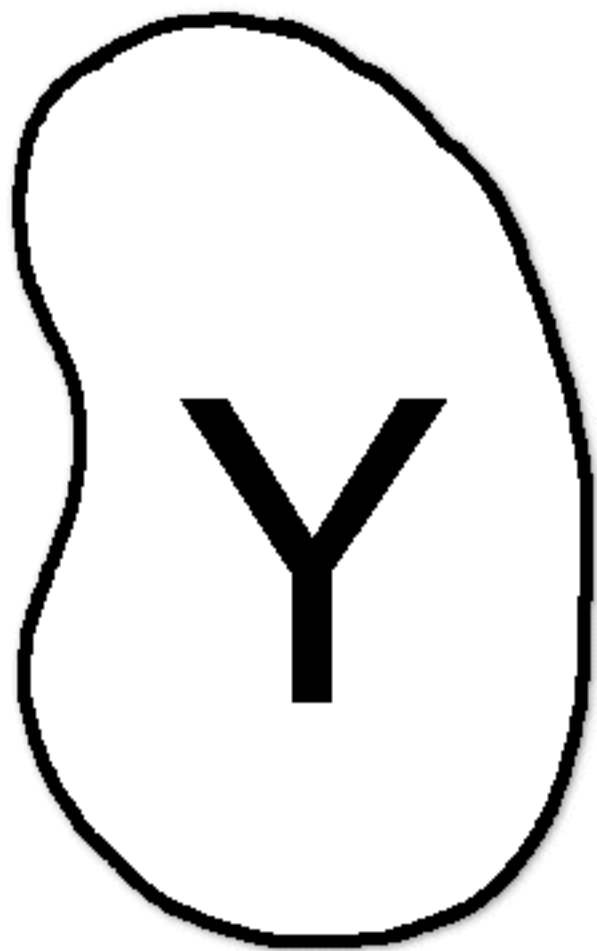


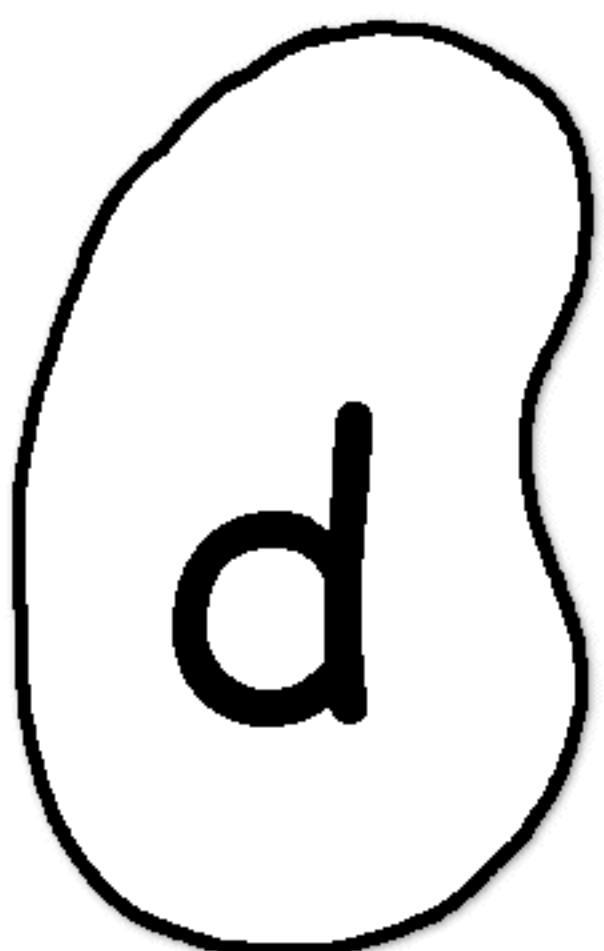
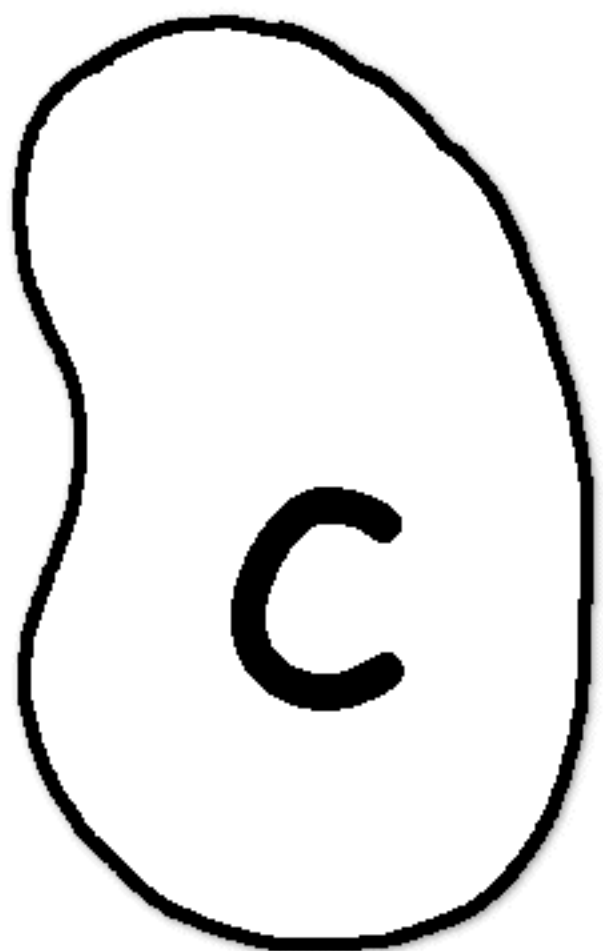
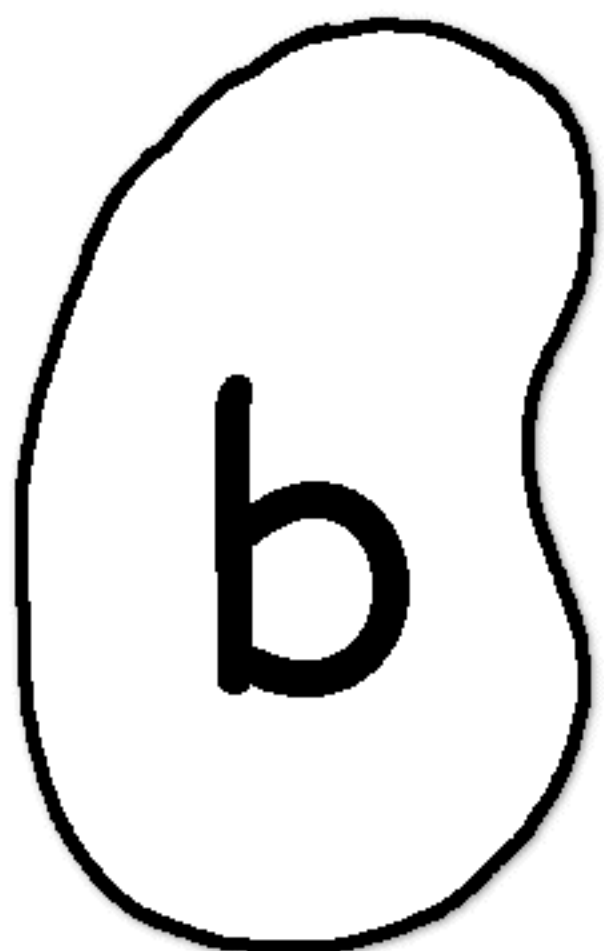
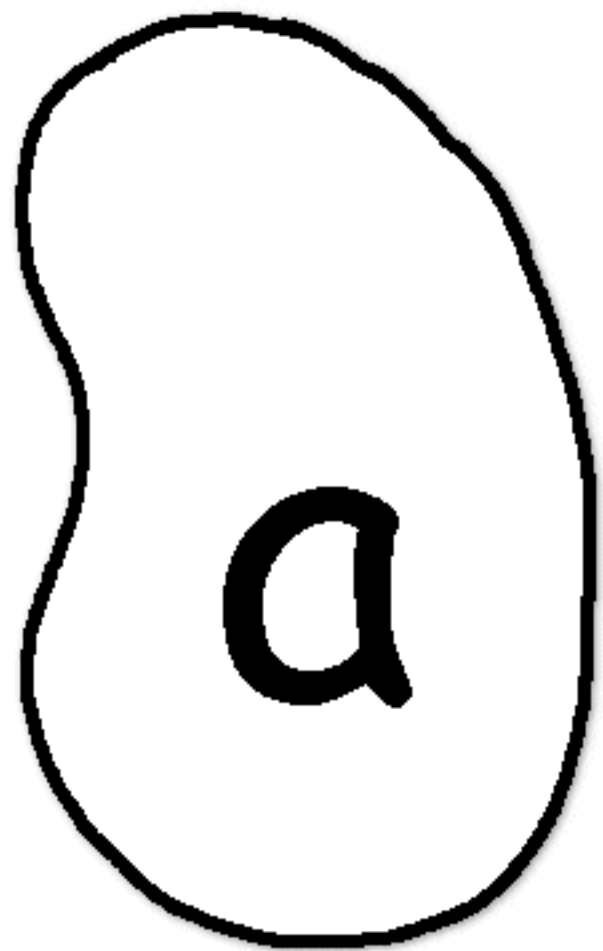


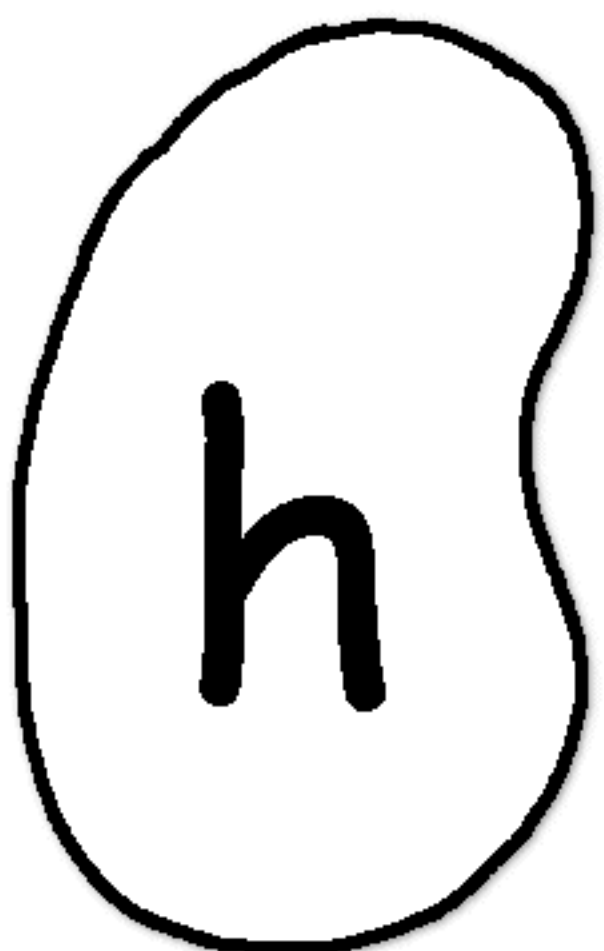
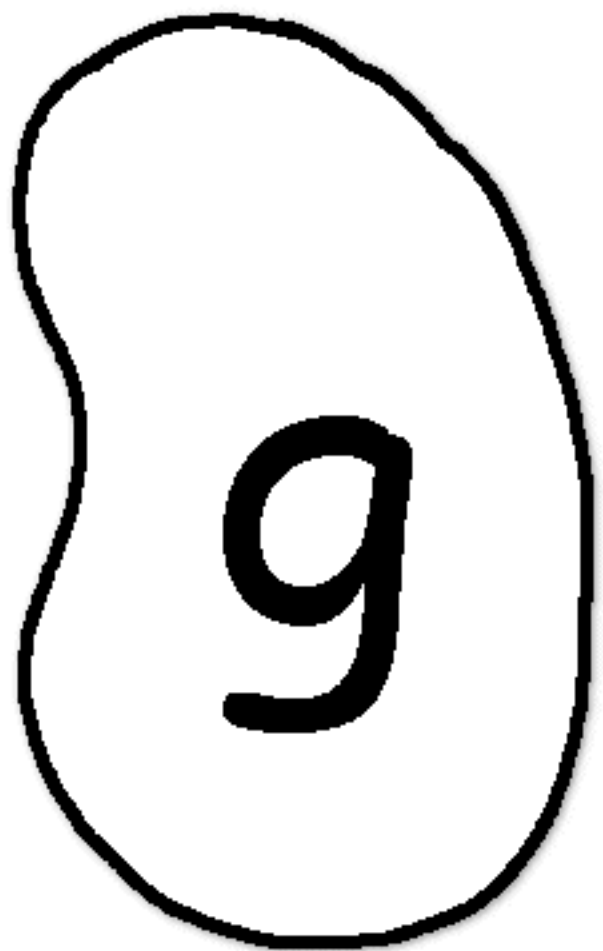
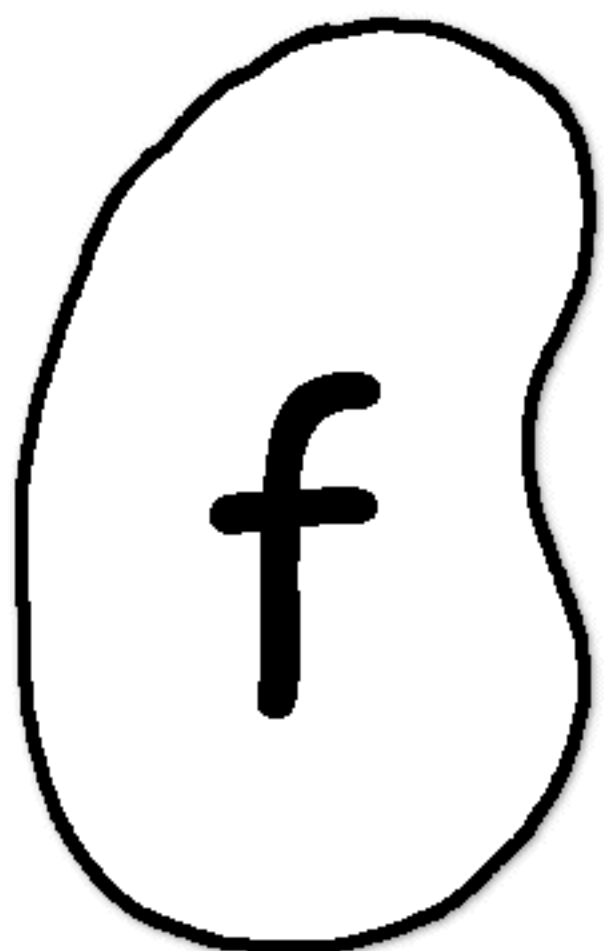
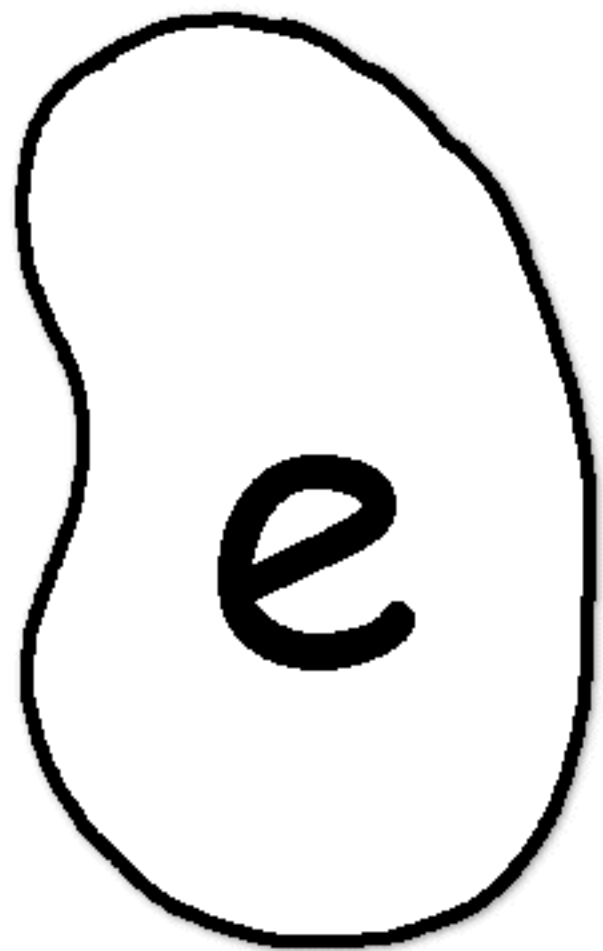


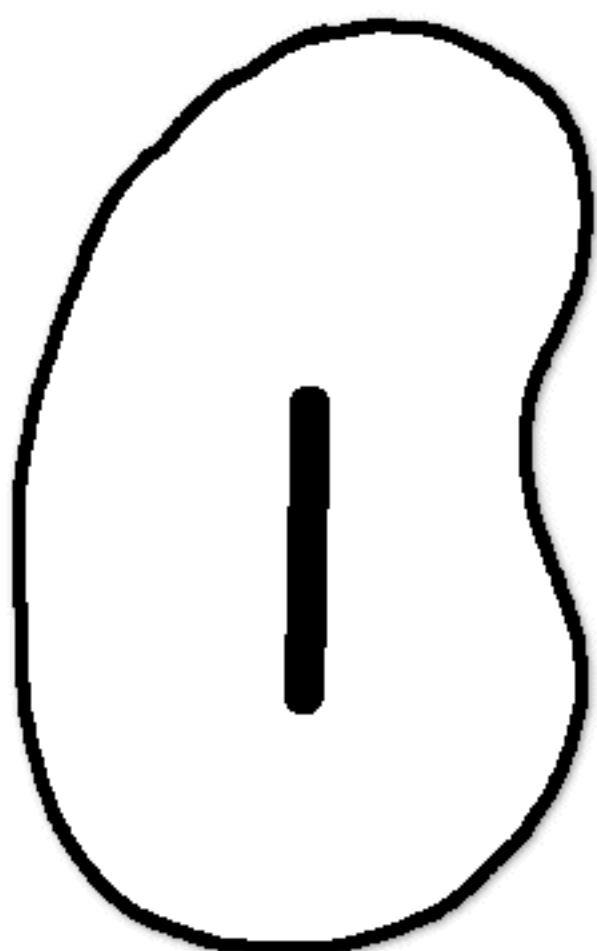
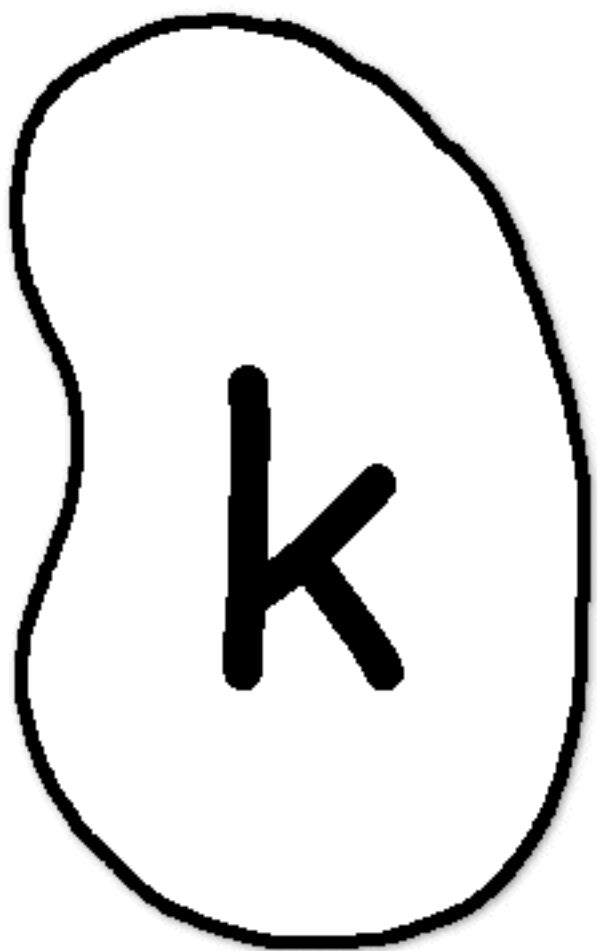
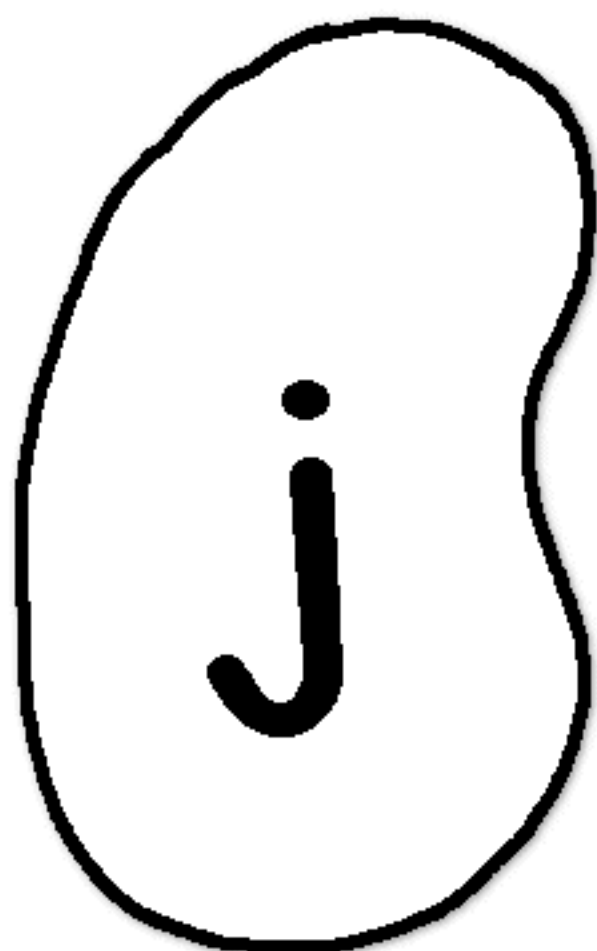
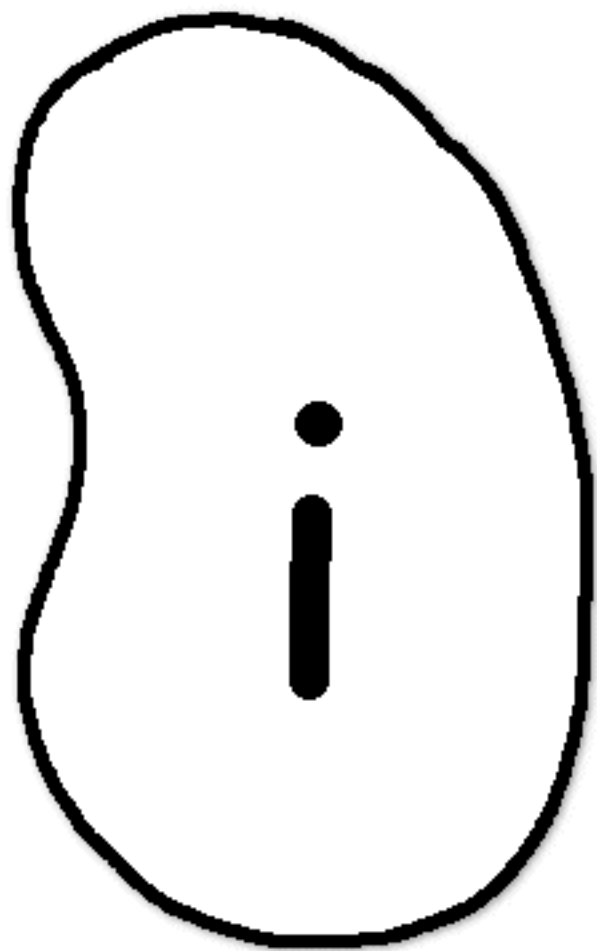


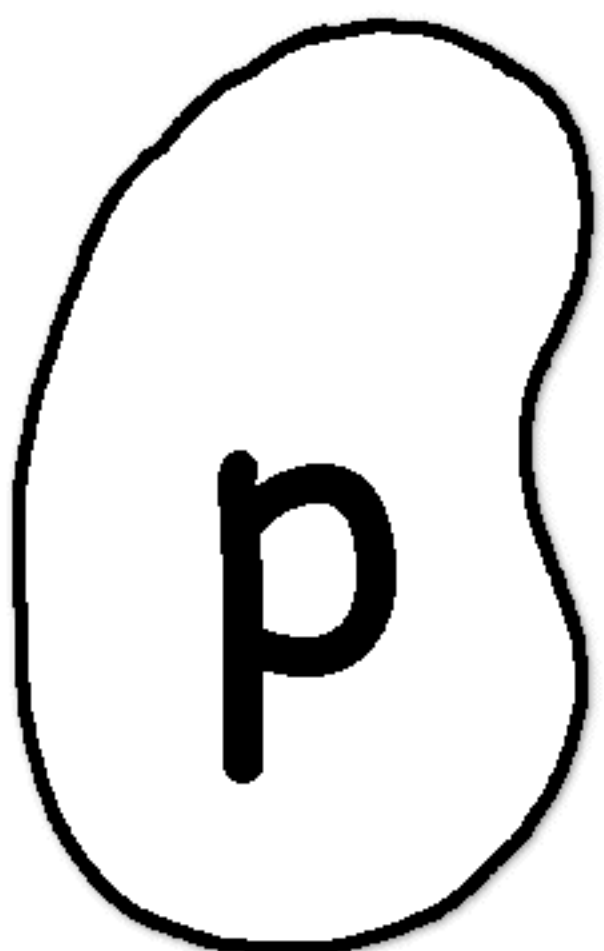
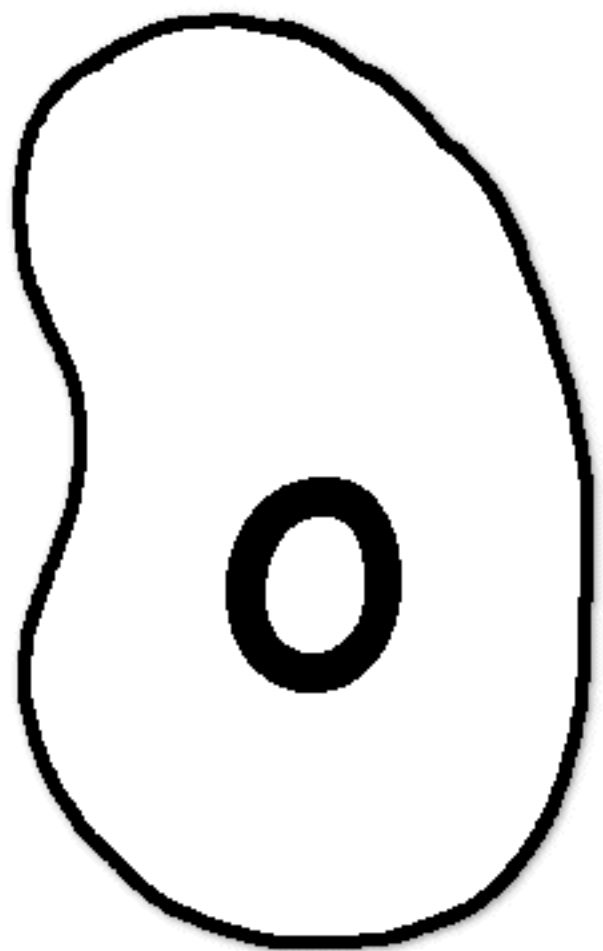
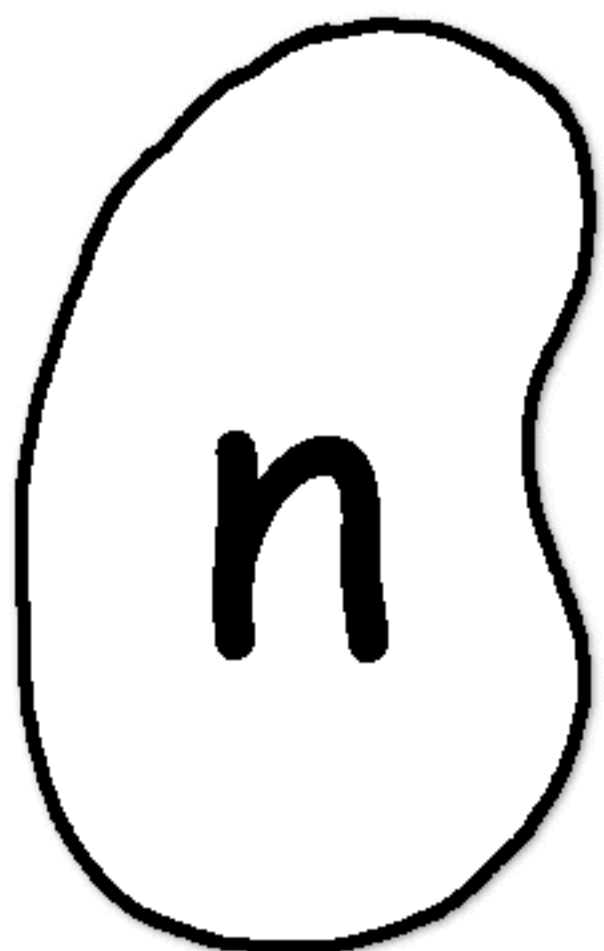
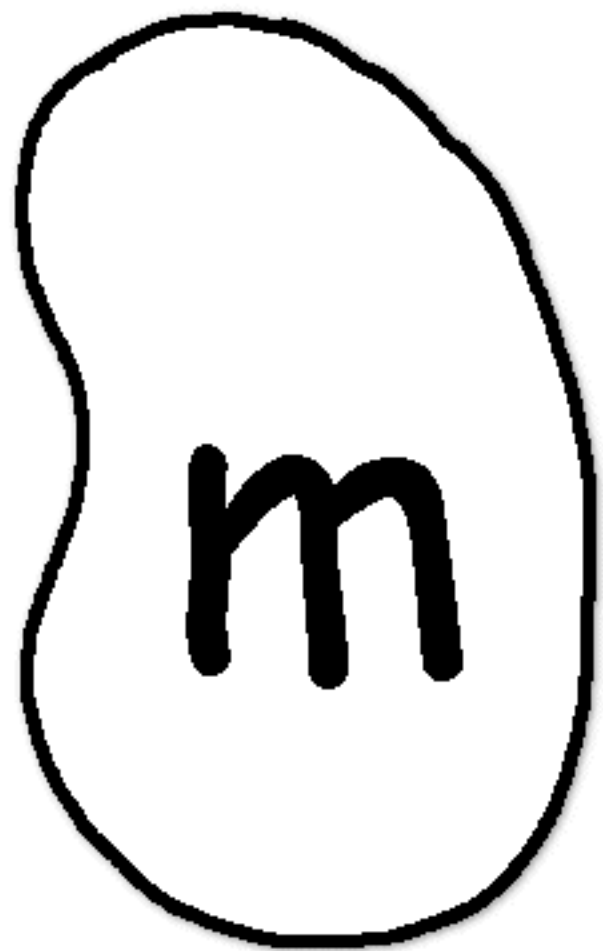


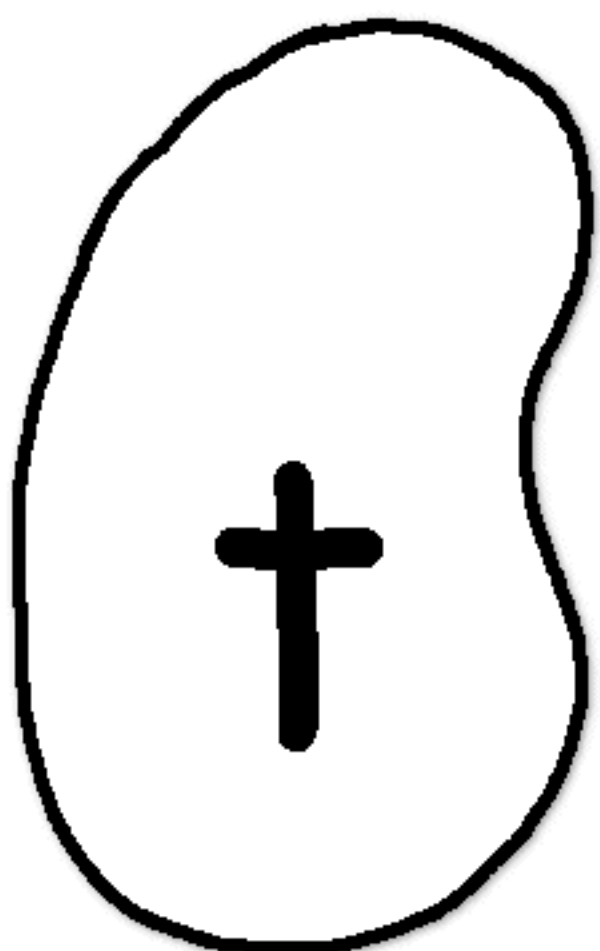
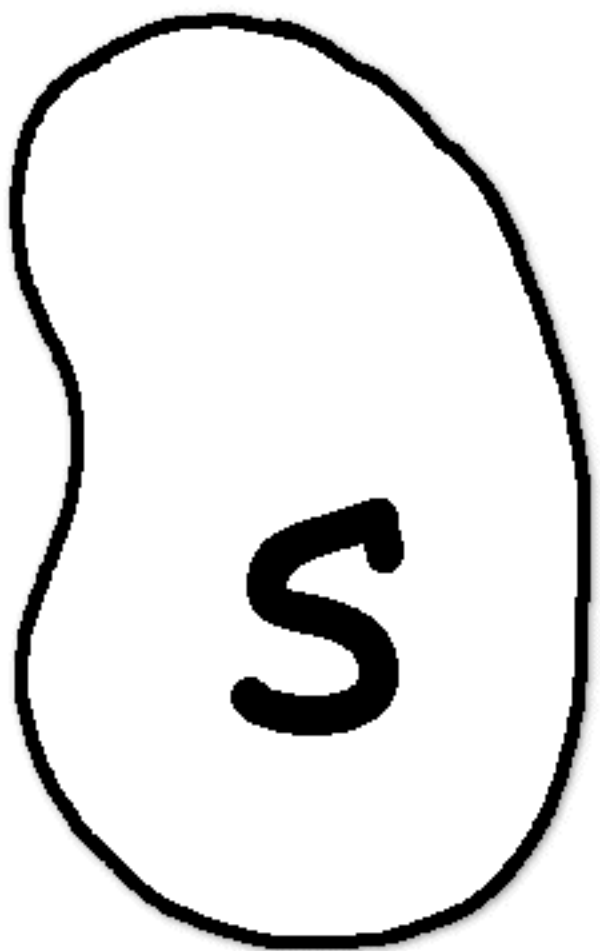
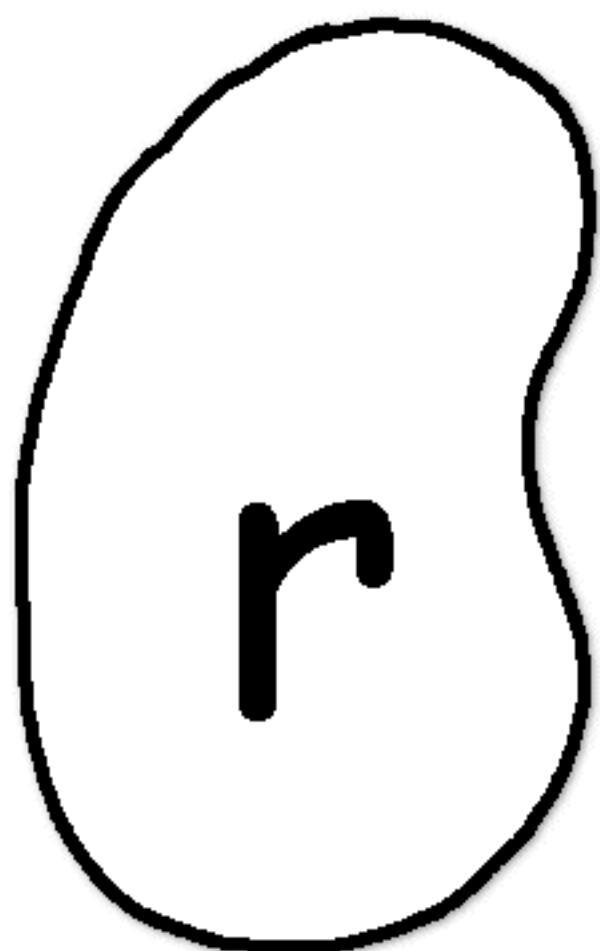
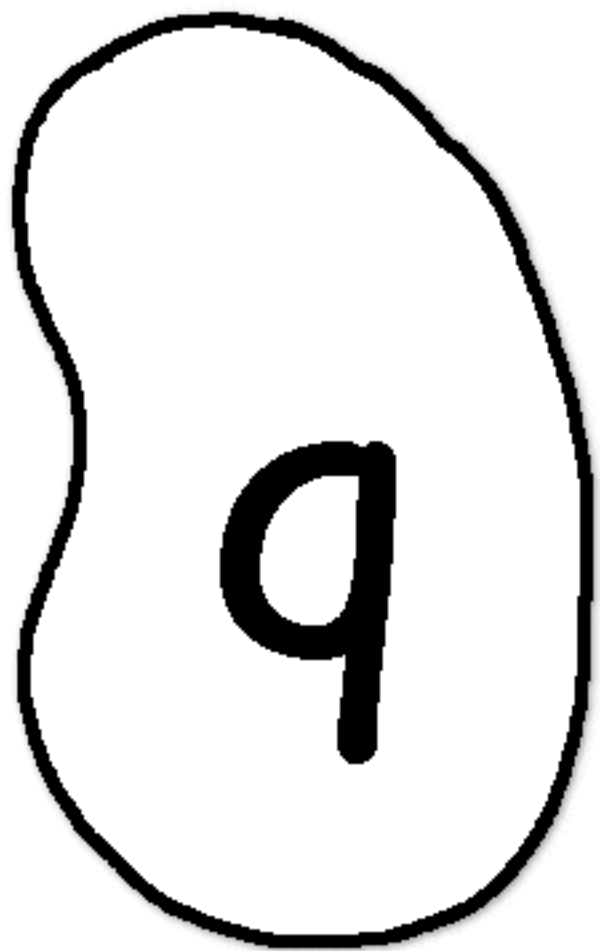


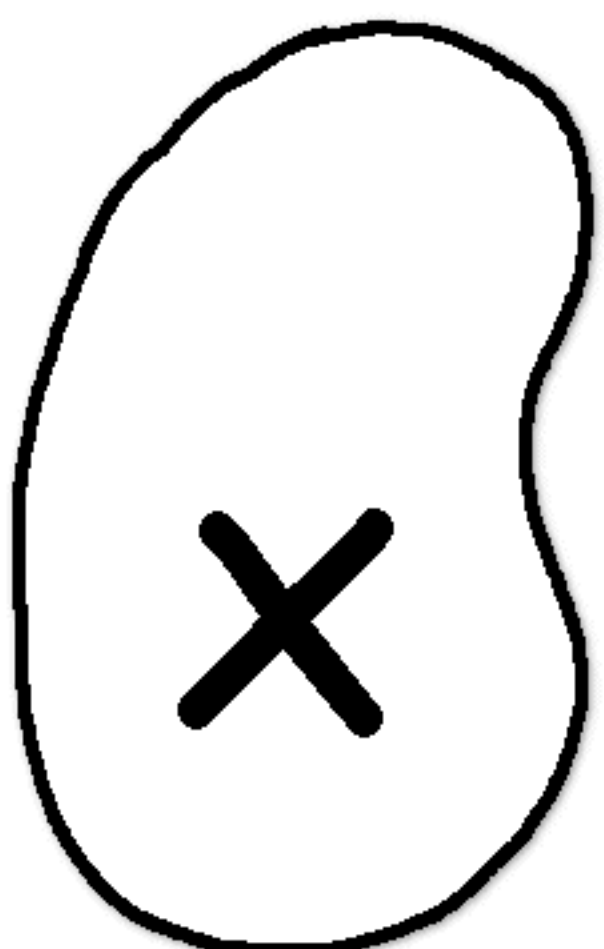
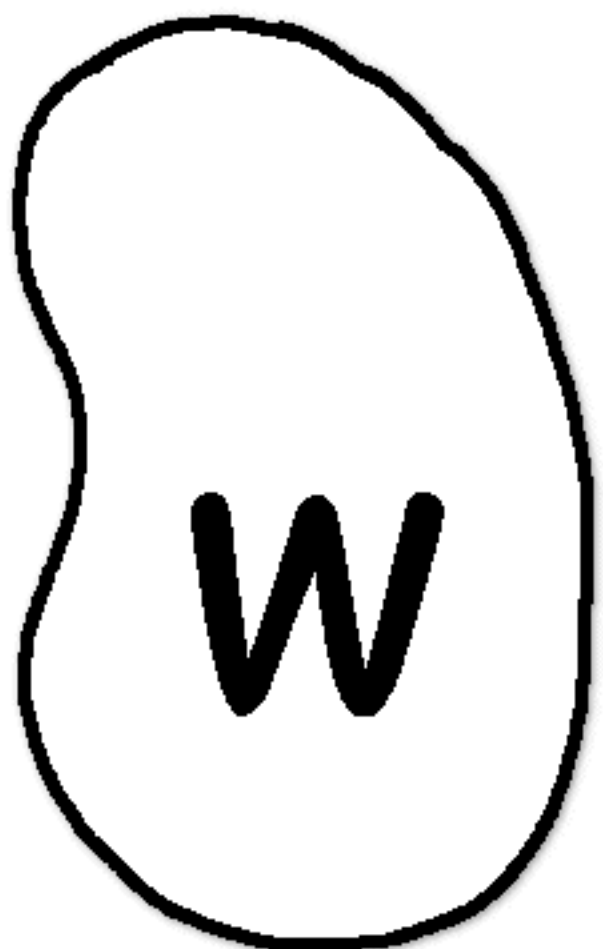
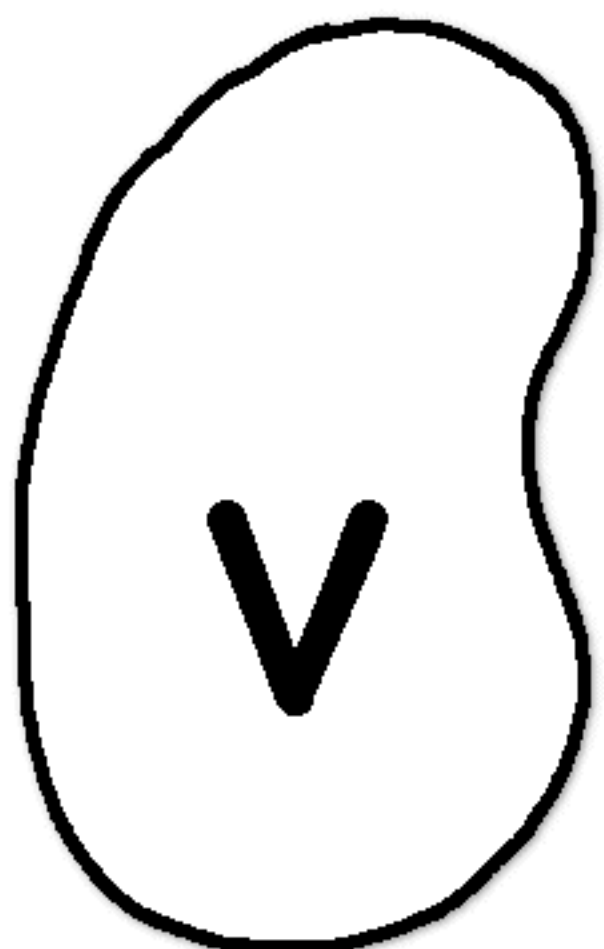
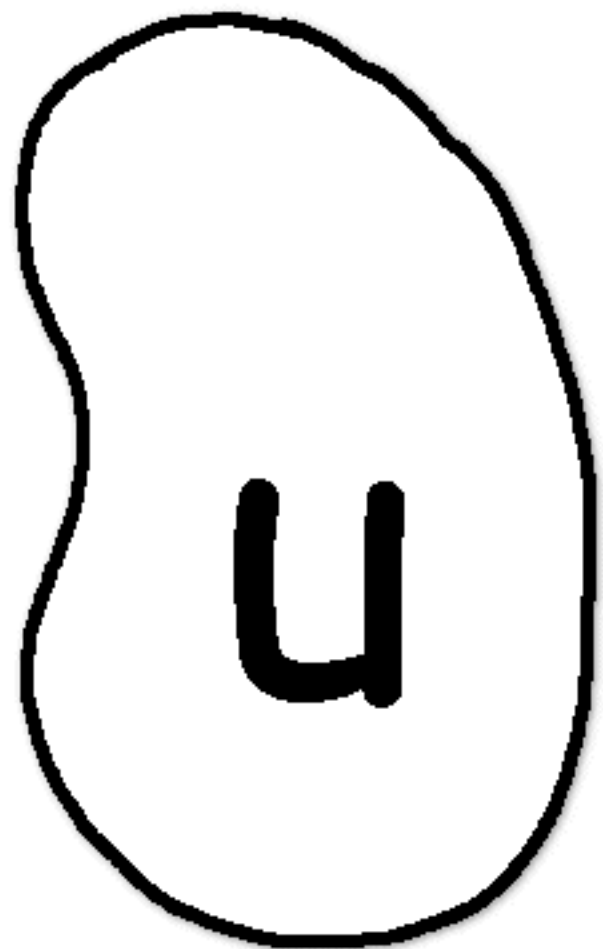


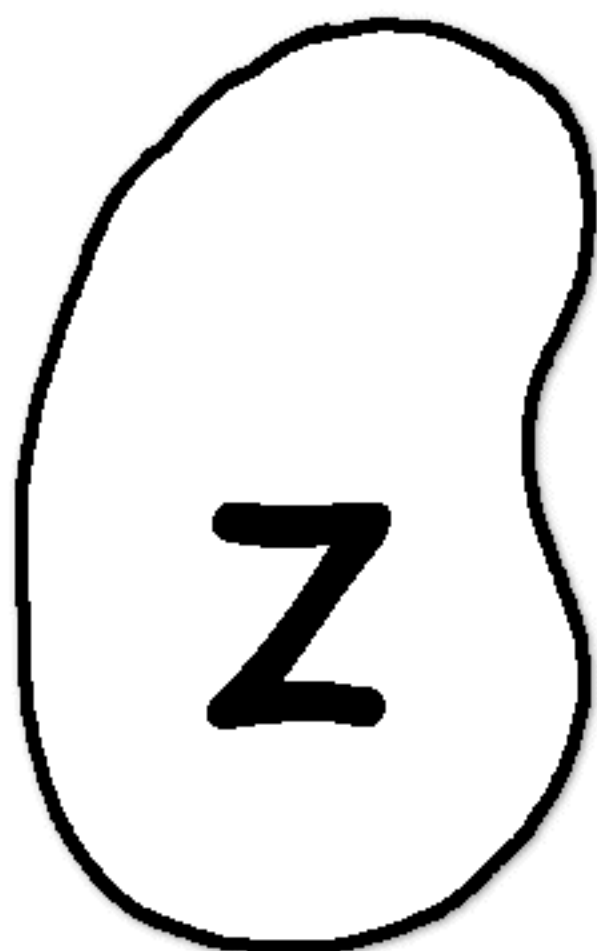
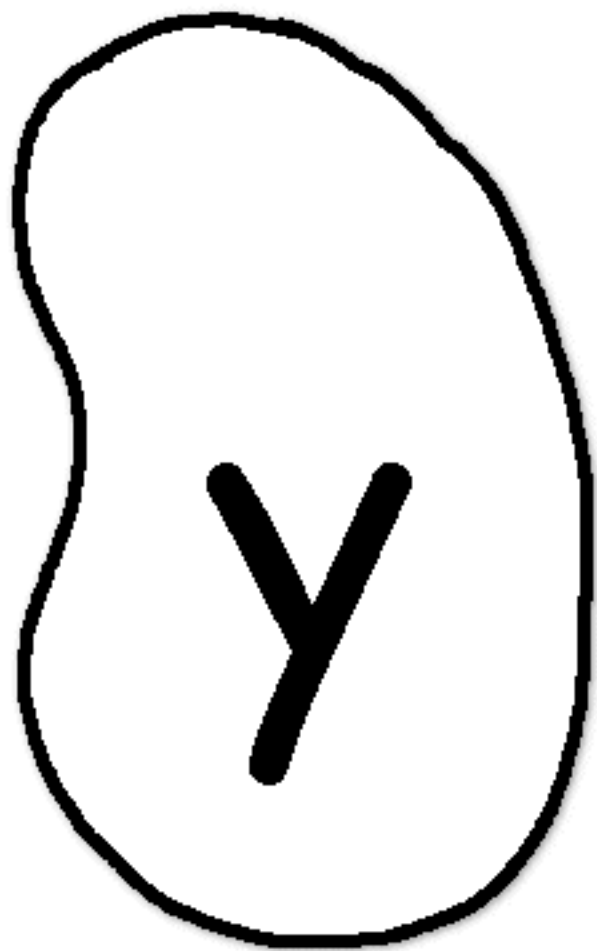












Jelly Bean Letter Sequence
