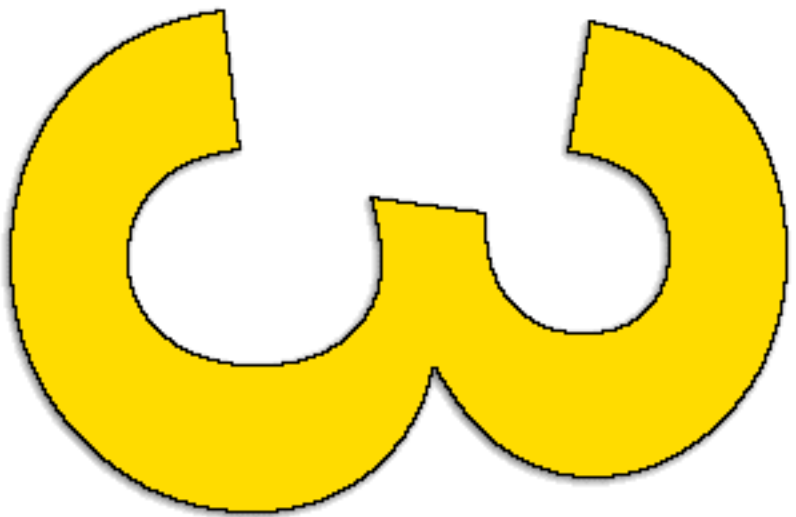
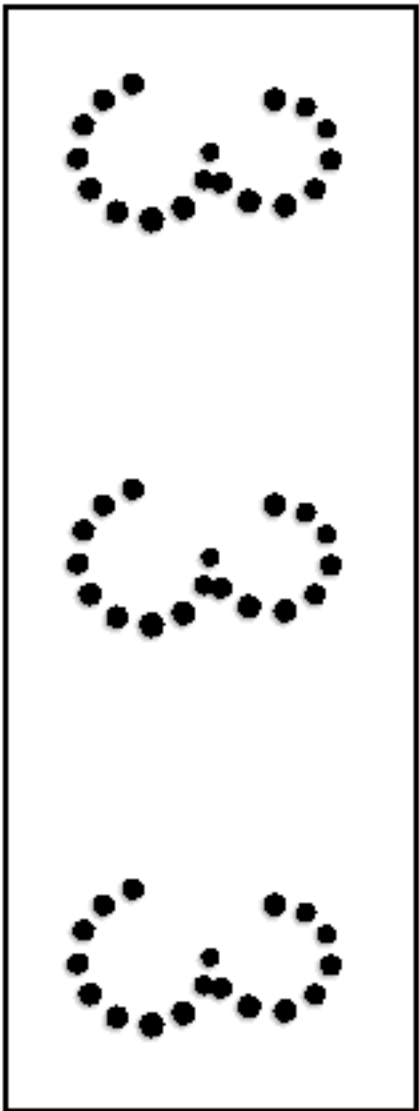
Glue cover sheet and end page on construction paper.

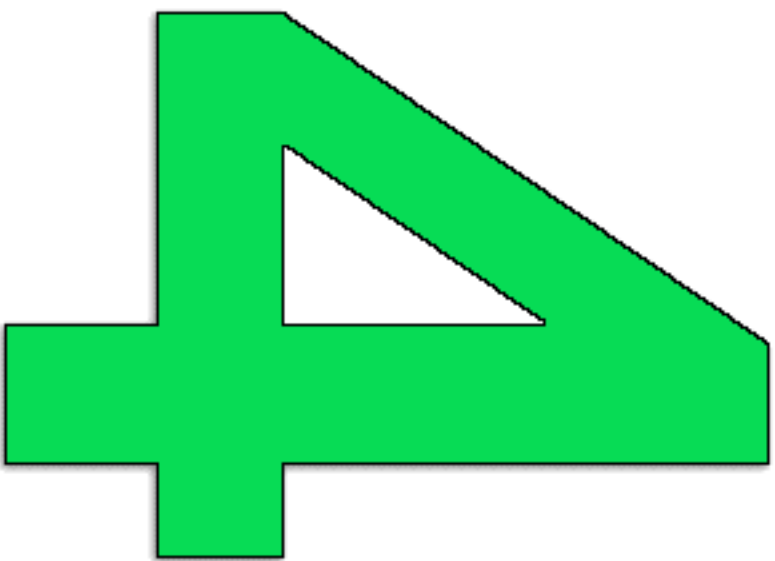
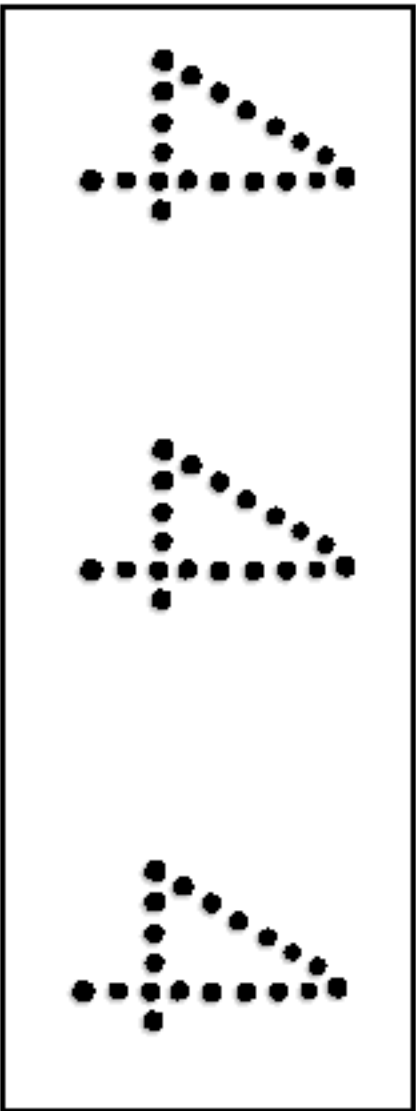
You can also draw or glue the items on and then laminate the page. Use wipe on wipe off markers to trace the numbers.

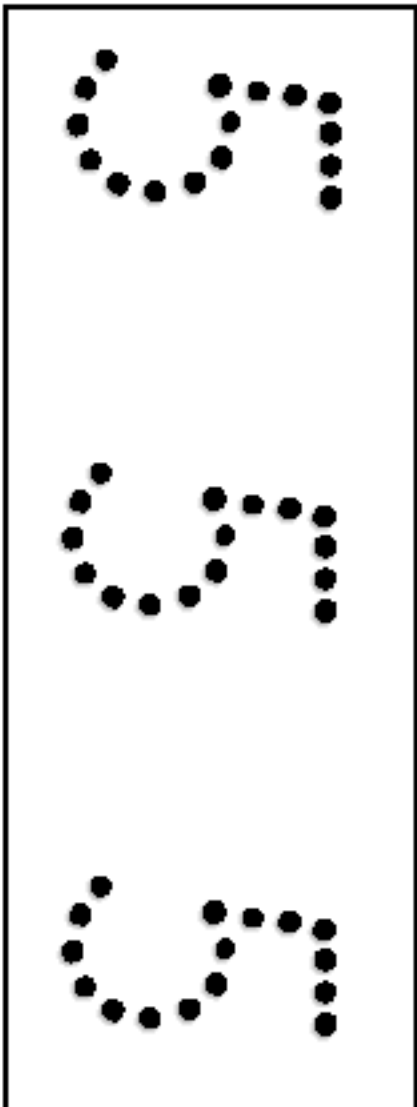
Book can be bound together at the top either using book rings or having it bound at an office supply store (about 1.50 per book) if you do not have a binding machine available.

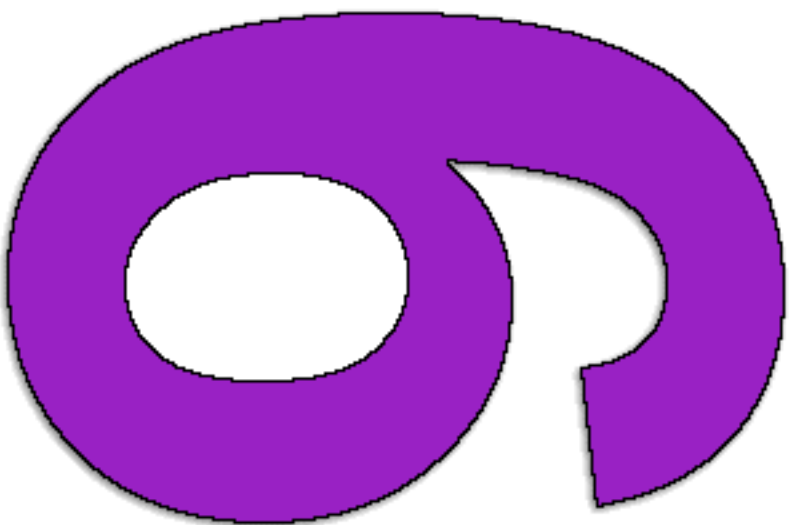
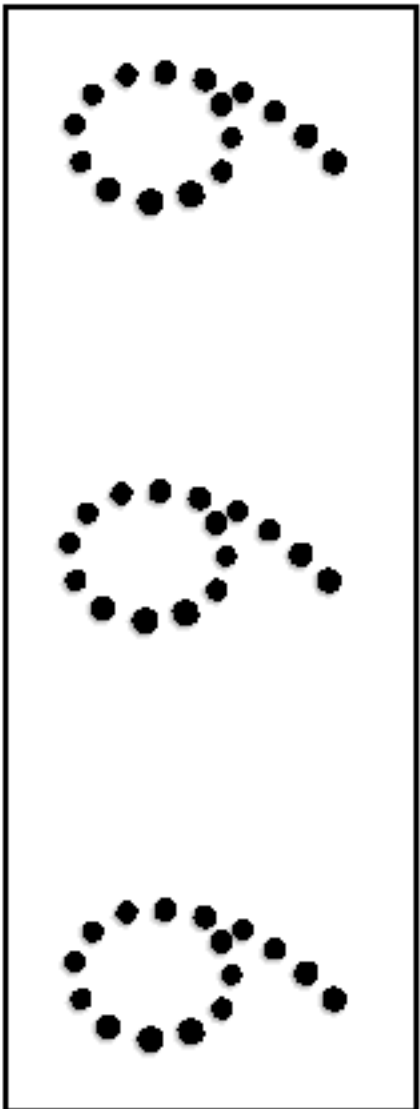




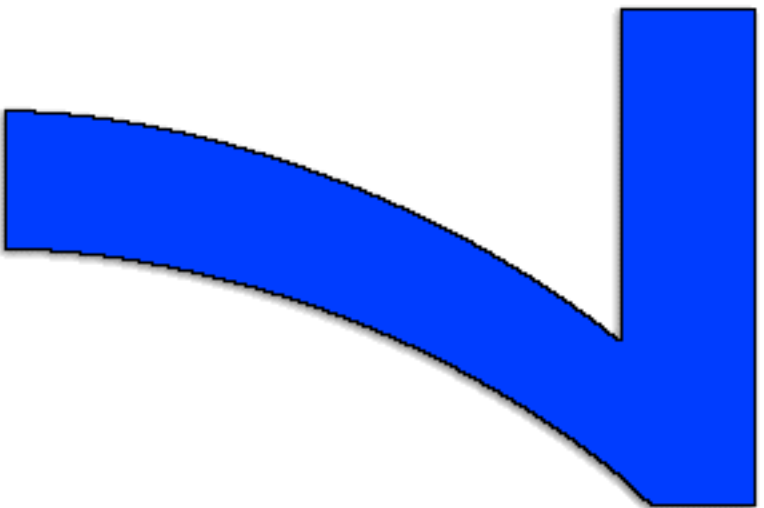
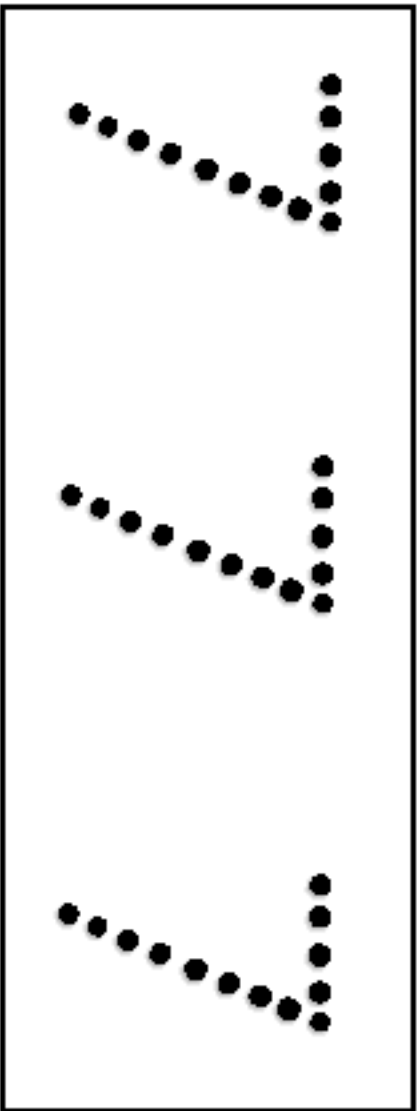


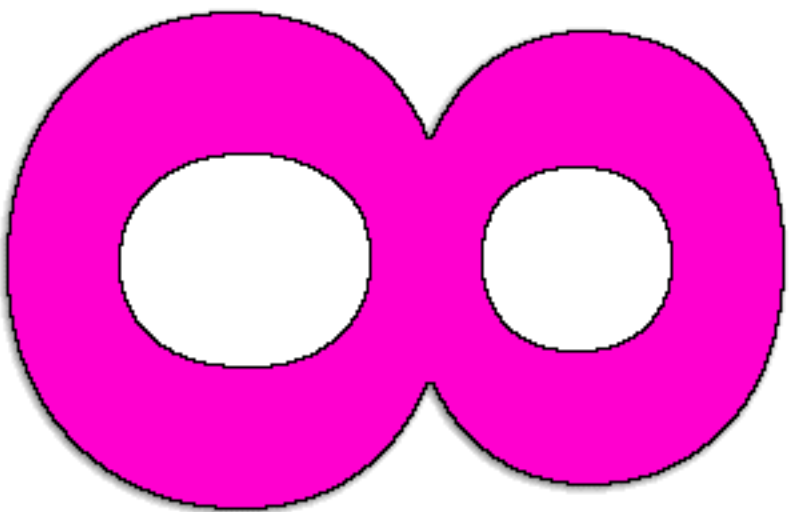
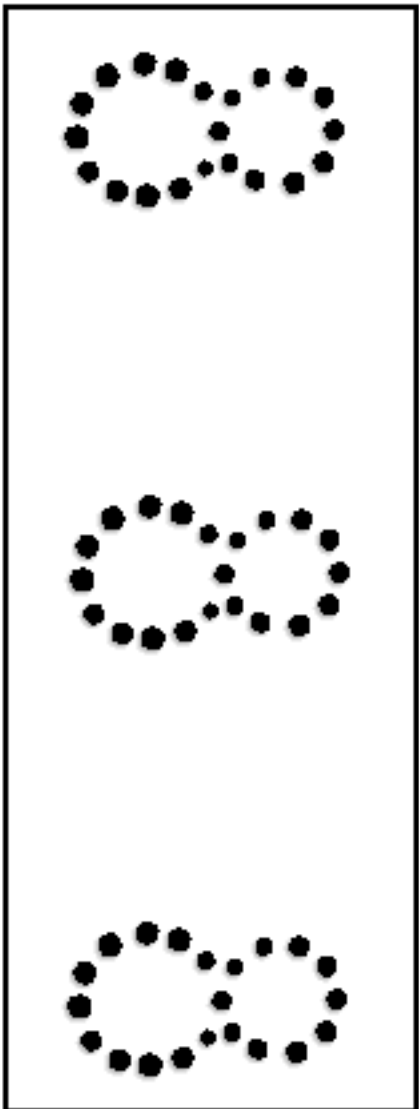


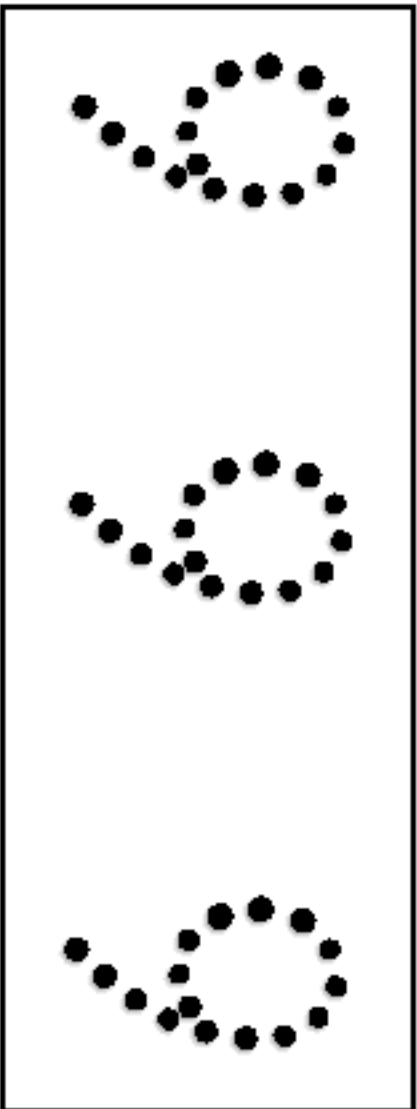
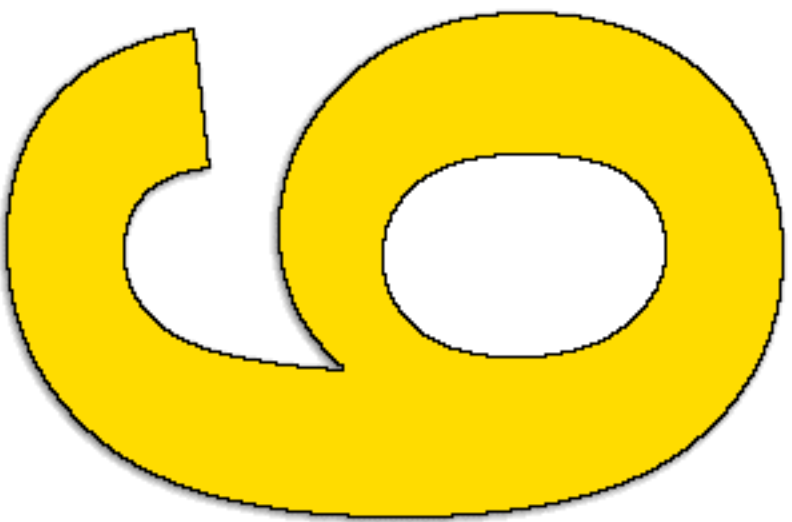


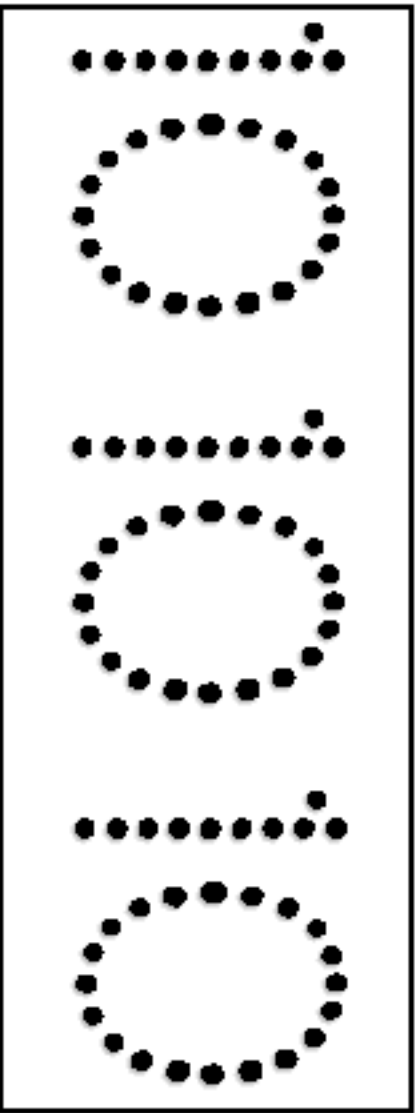
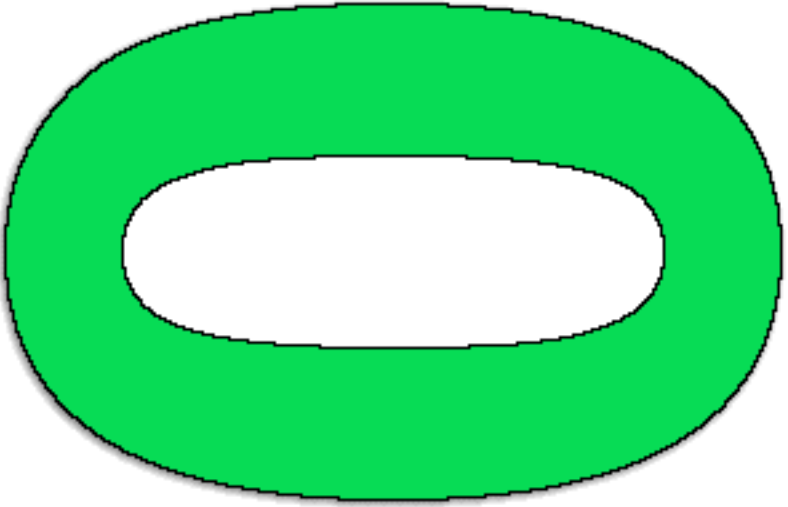
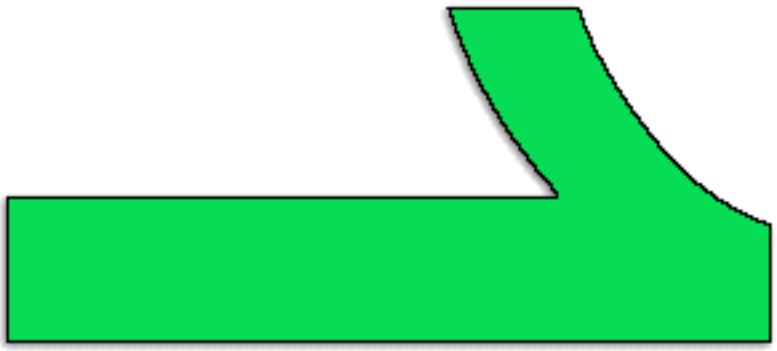


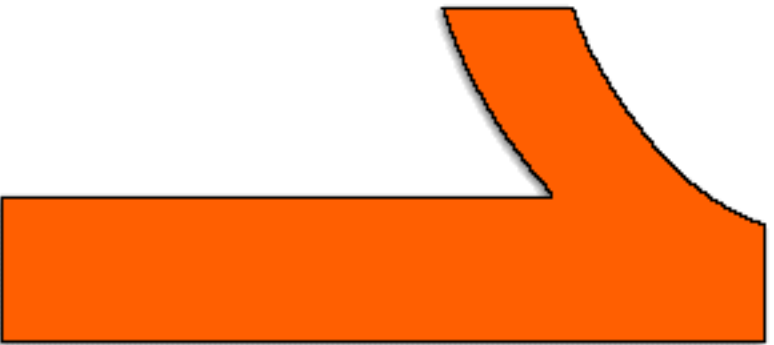
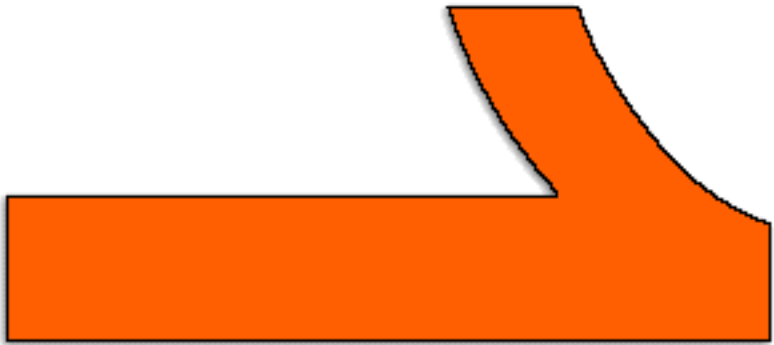
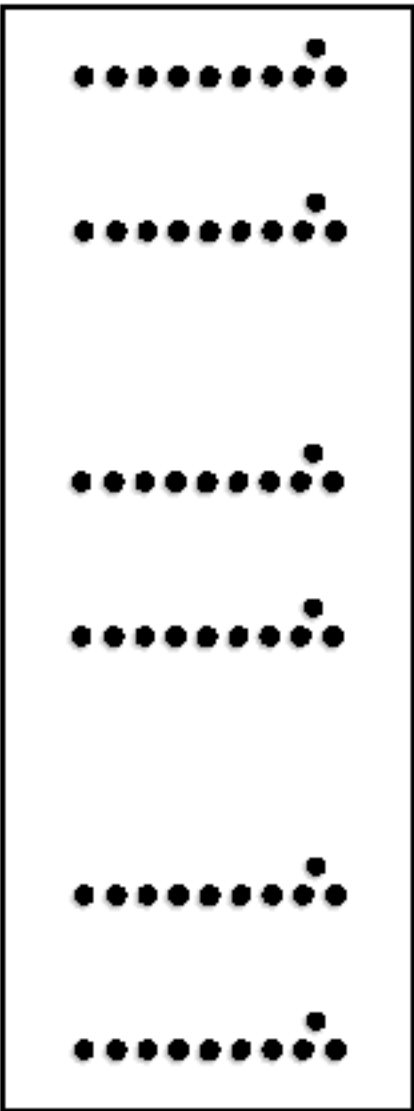


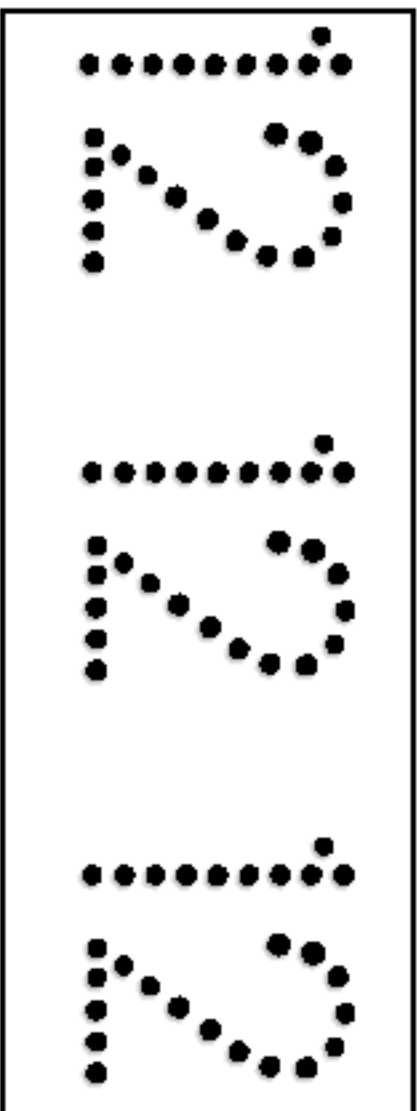
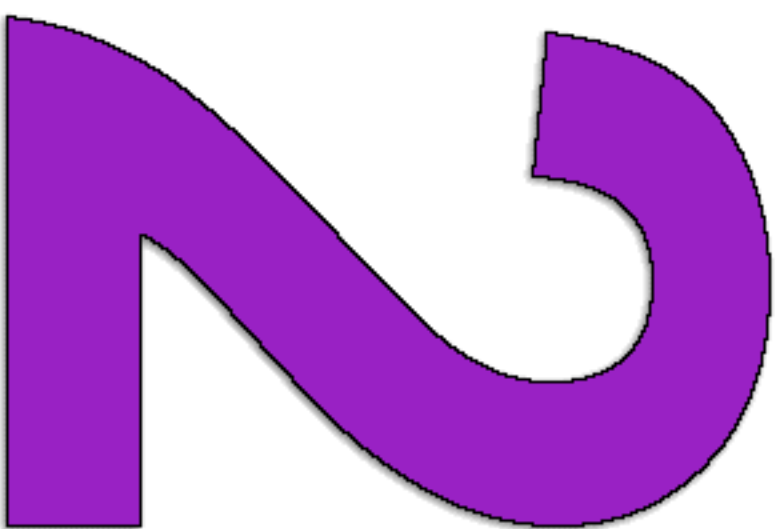
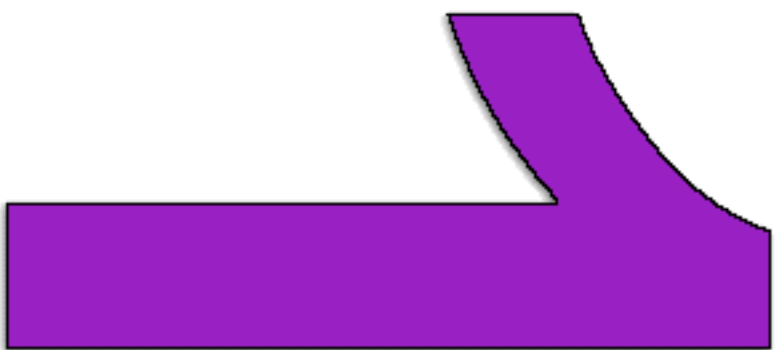


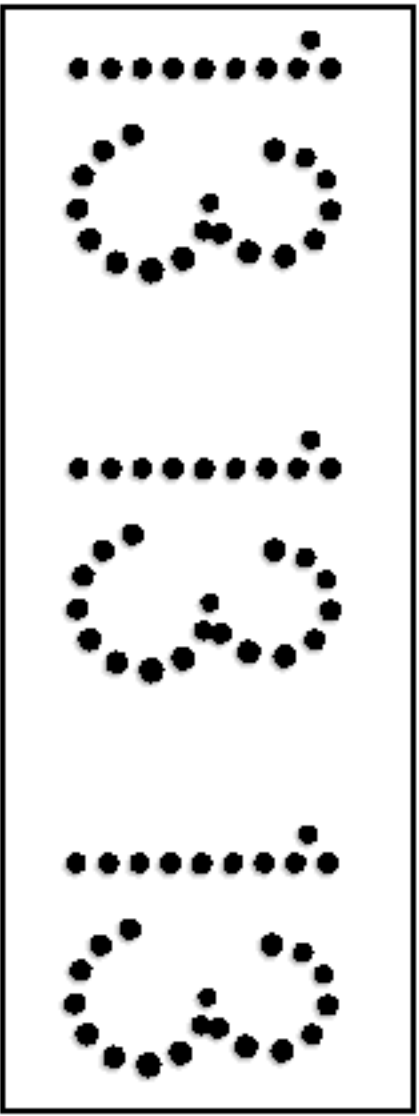
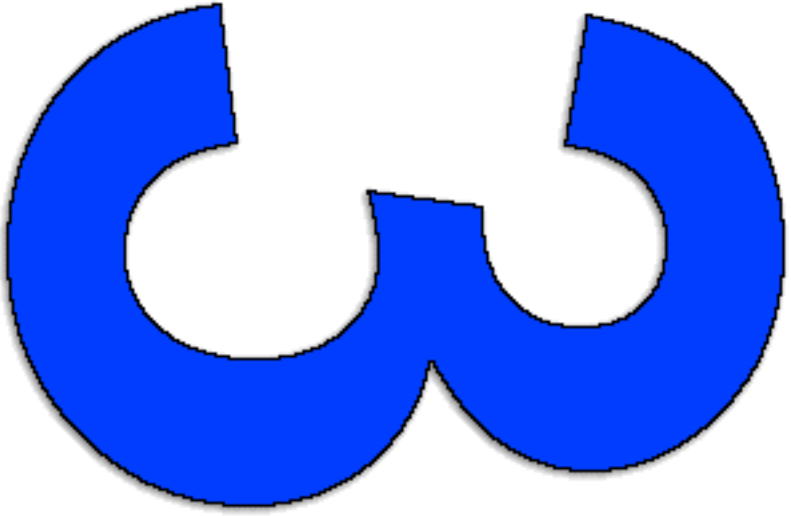
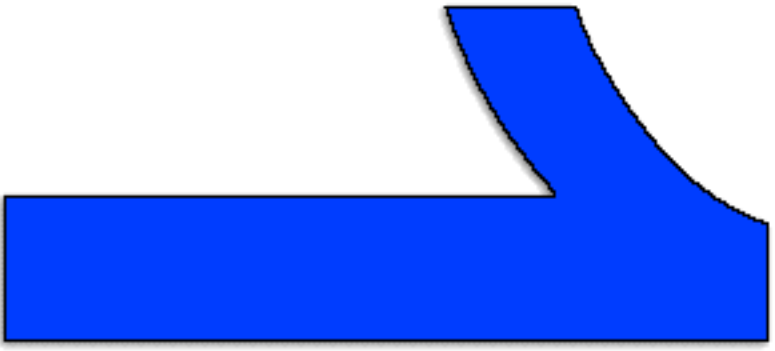


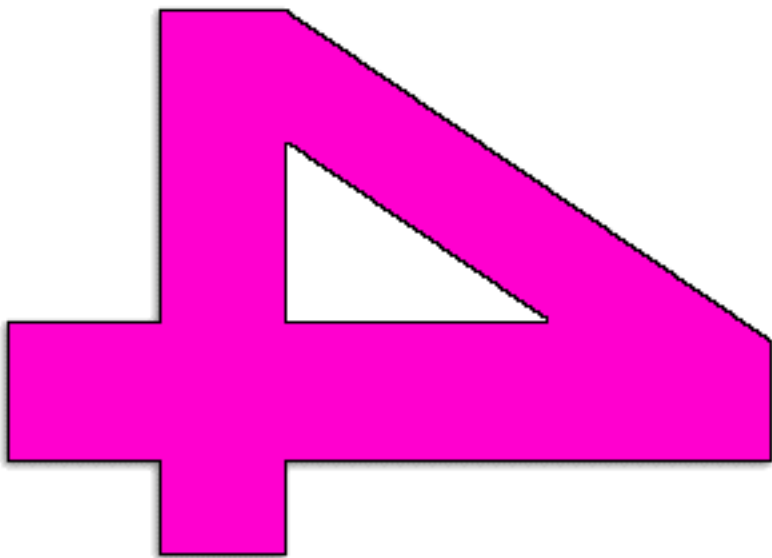
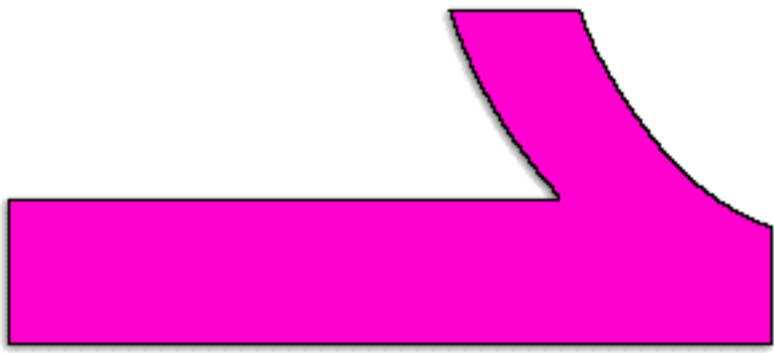
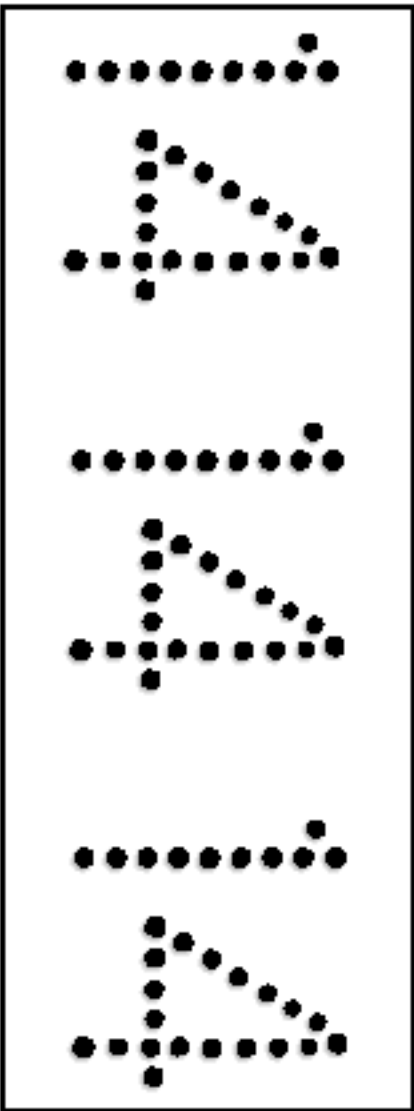




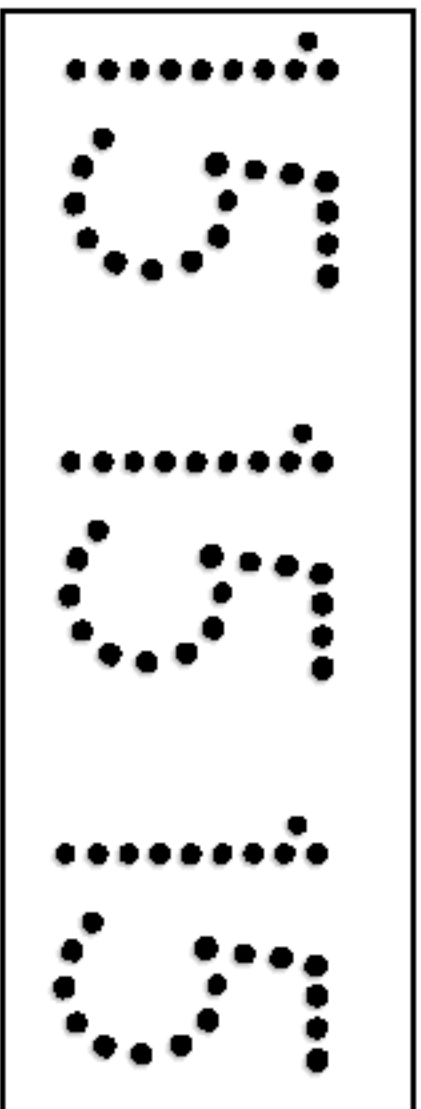
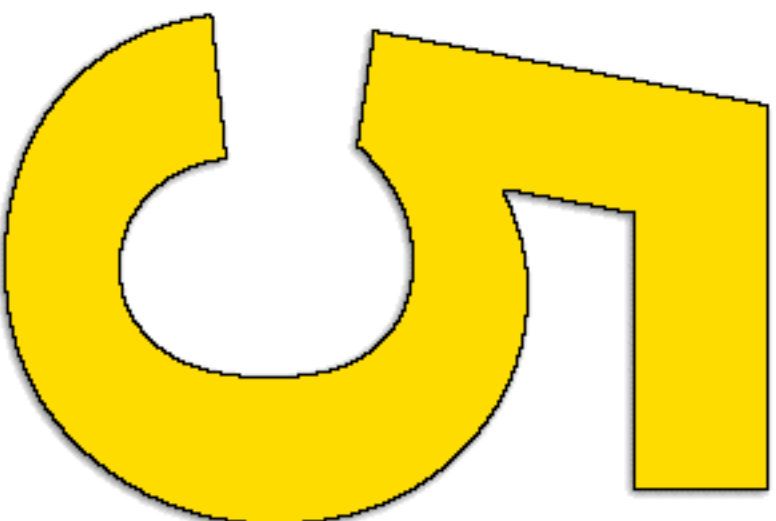
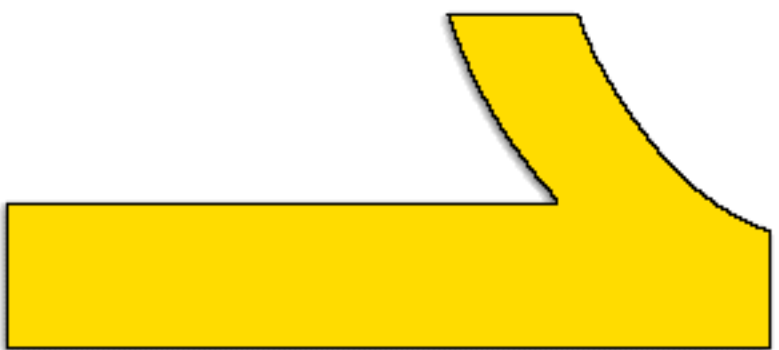


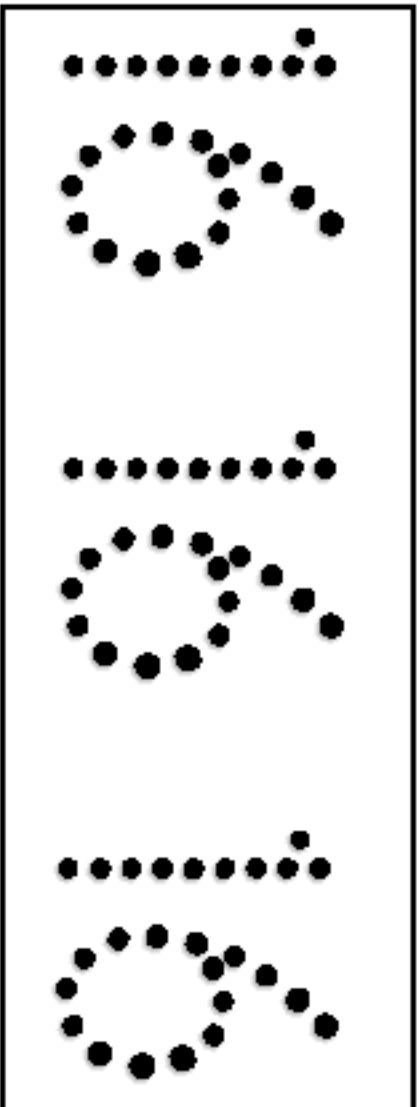
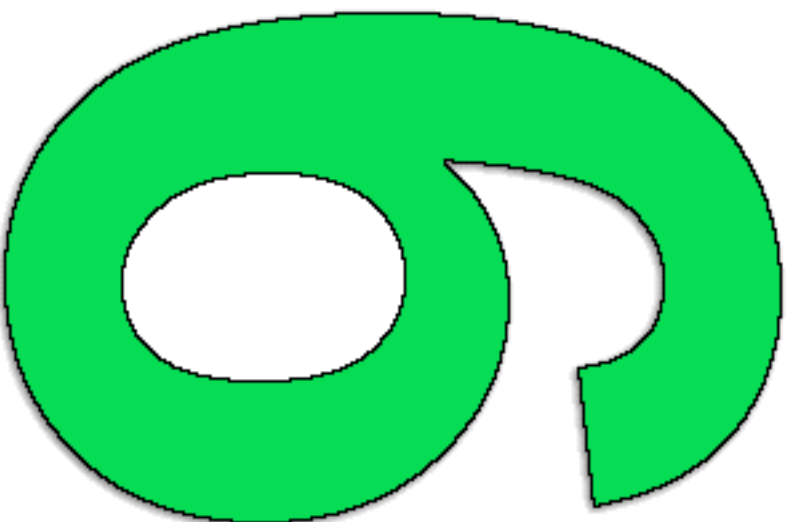
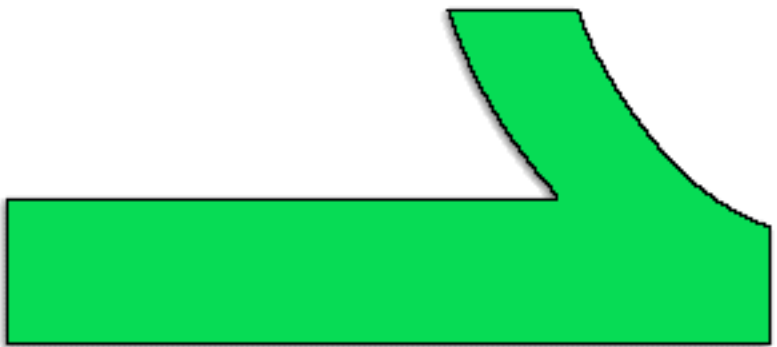


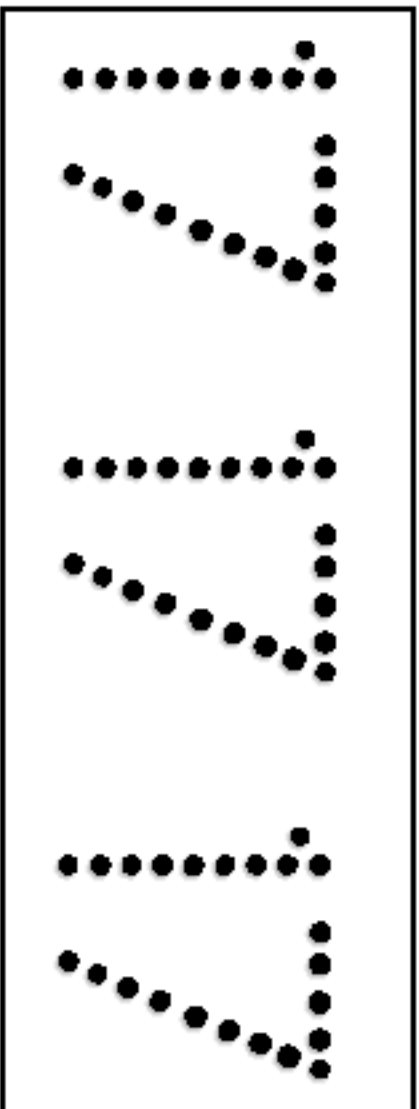
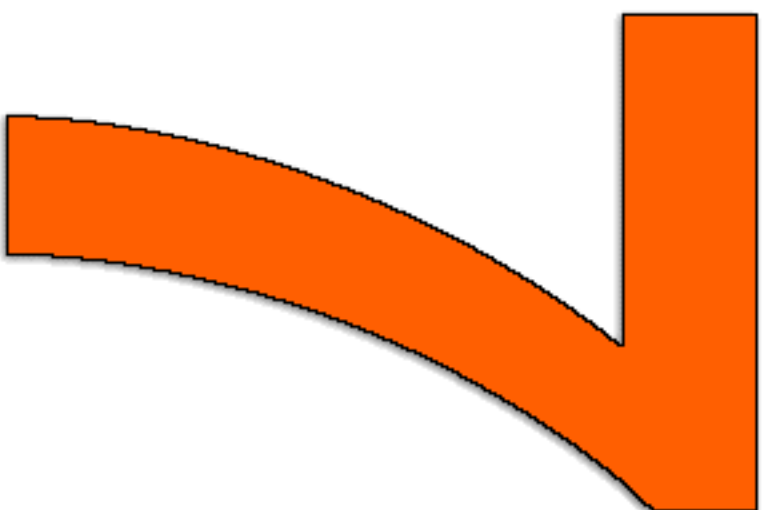
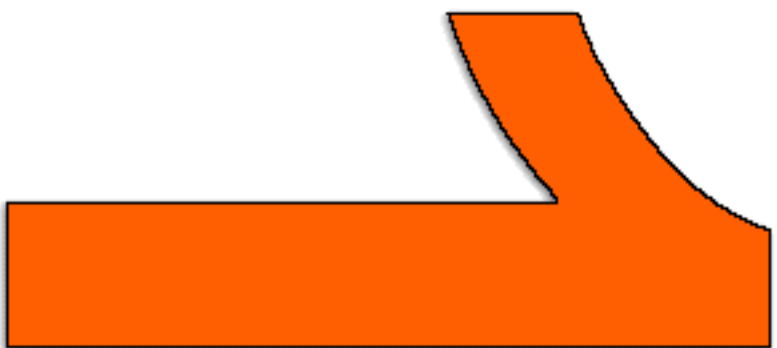


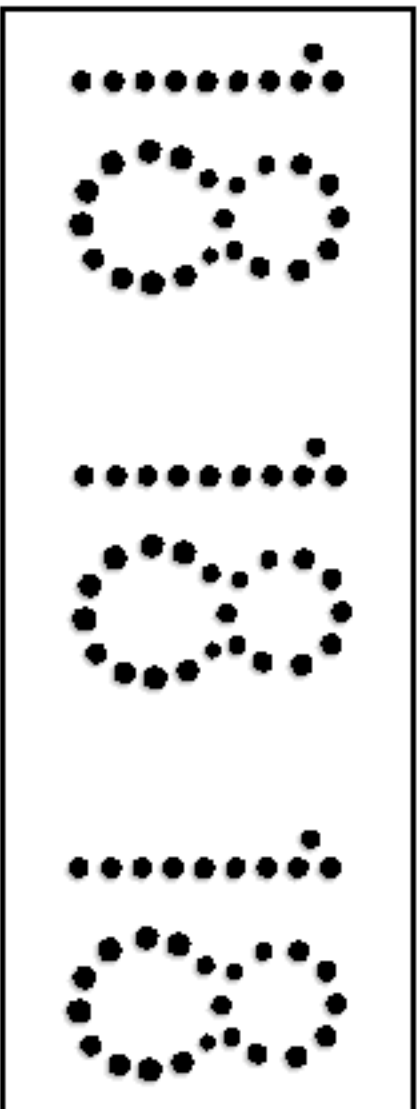
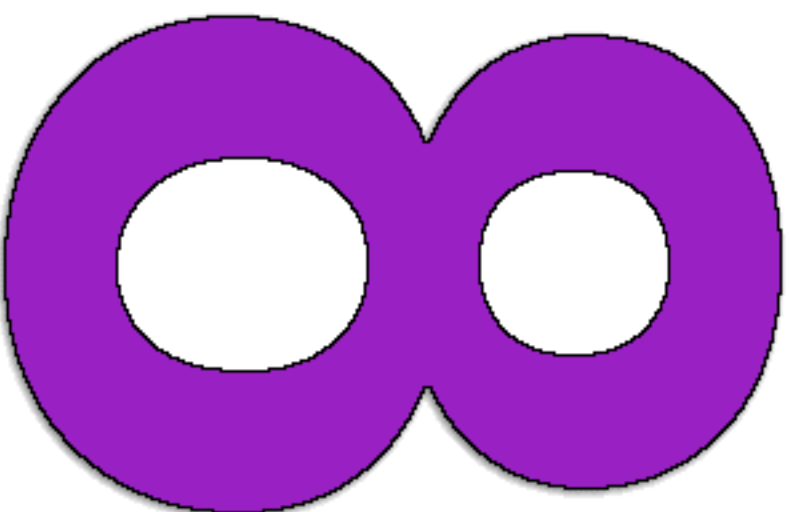
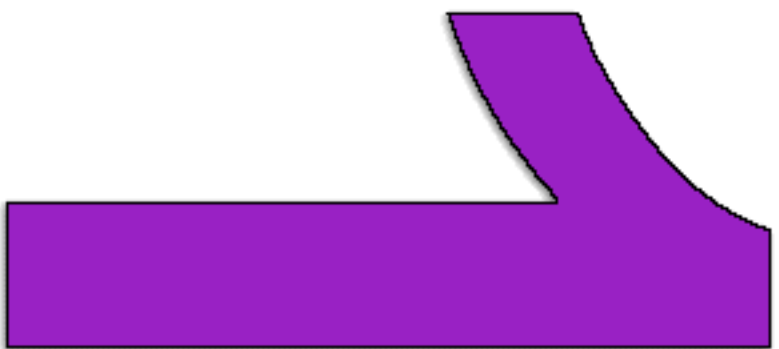


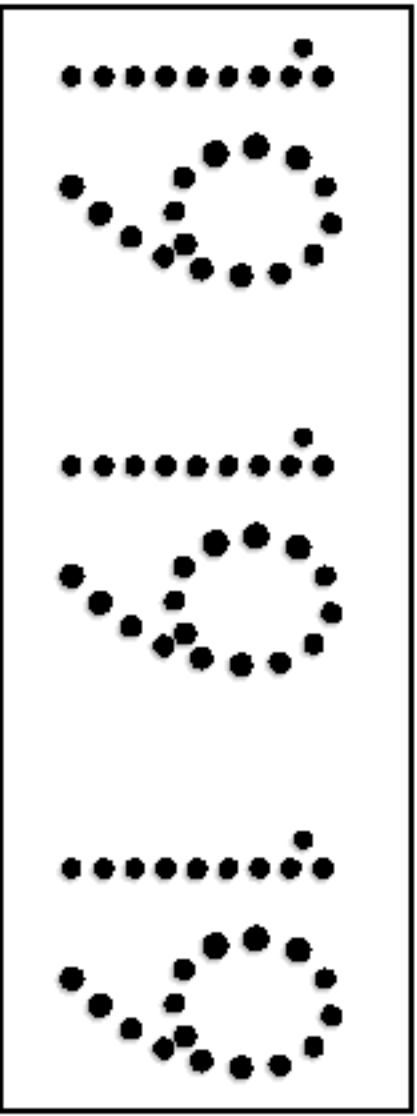
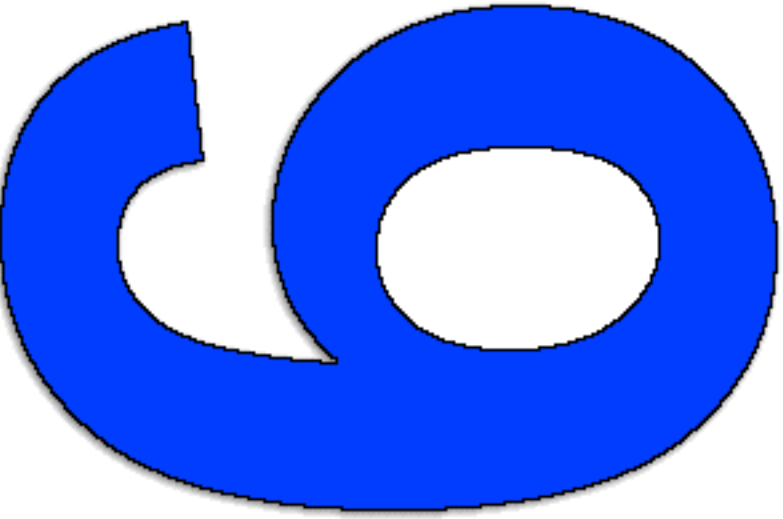
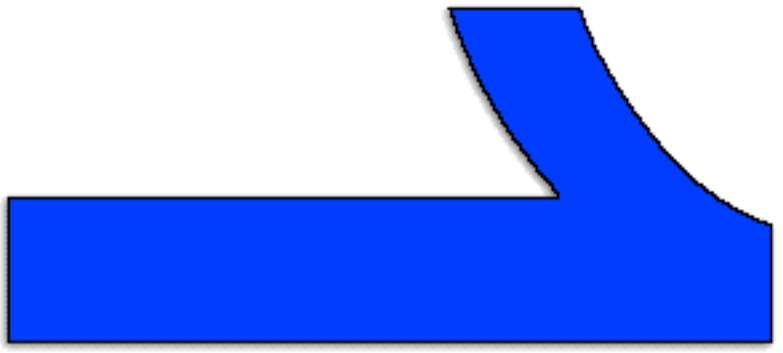


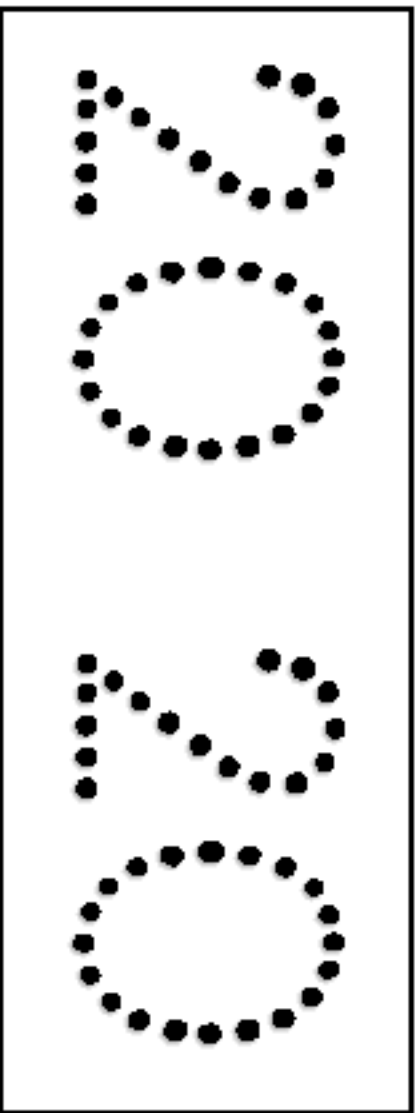
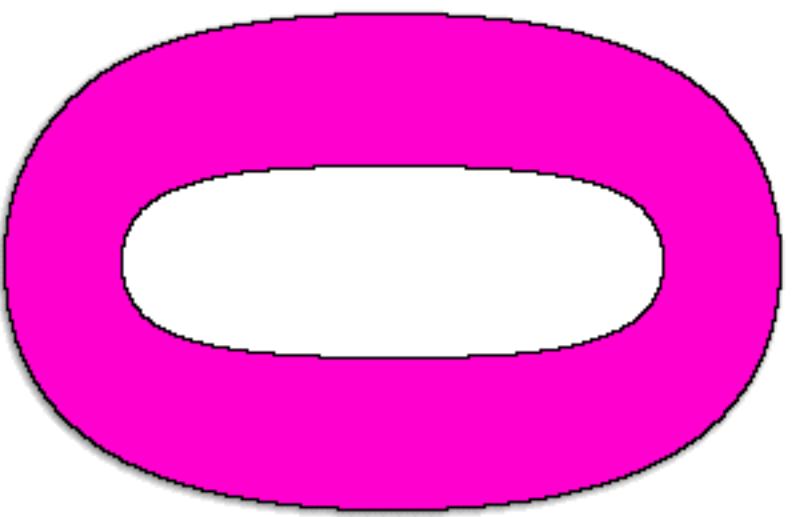
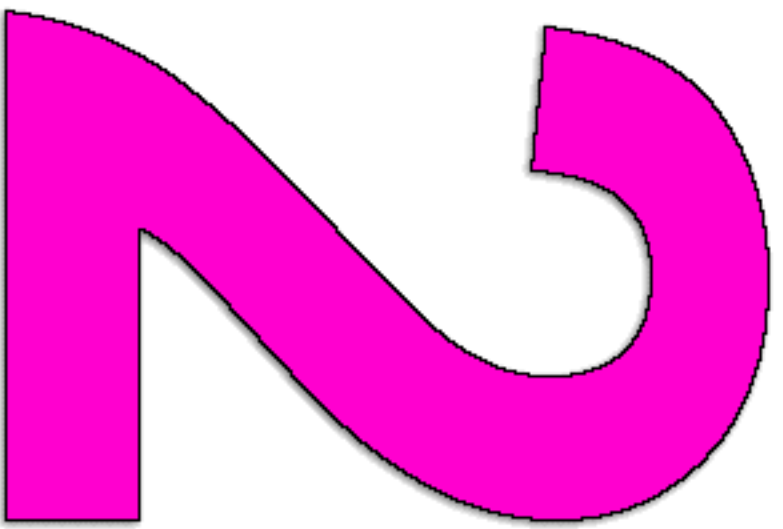
