




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
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
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
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



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
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





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
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
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
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


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Spider Alphabet Memory Match Game

Instructions: Print two copies on cardstock paper. Cut out and laminate. Choose the cards you want to use for the game (use less for younger children more for older children). Mix cards up and lay face down in several rows on the floor or table. The first child turn one card over and then a second card over. If the two do not match the child turns the cards back over and the next child takes a turn. If the cards do match the child removes the cards and takes another turn. Play continues until all matches have been made.
