

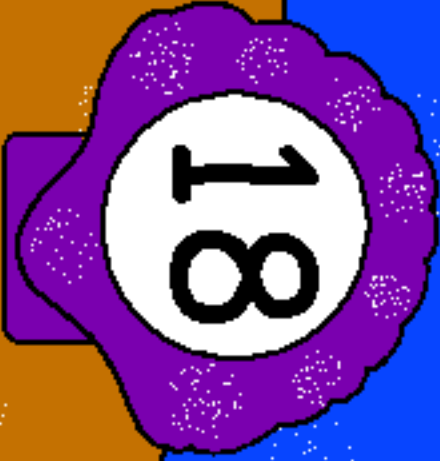
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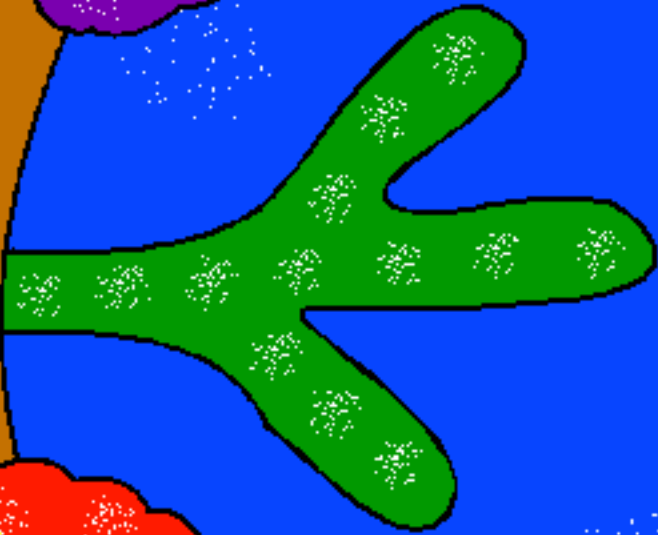
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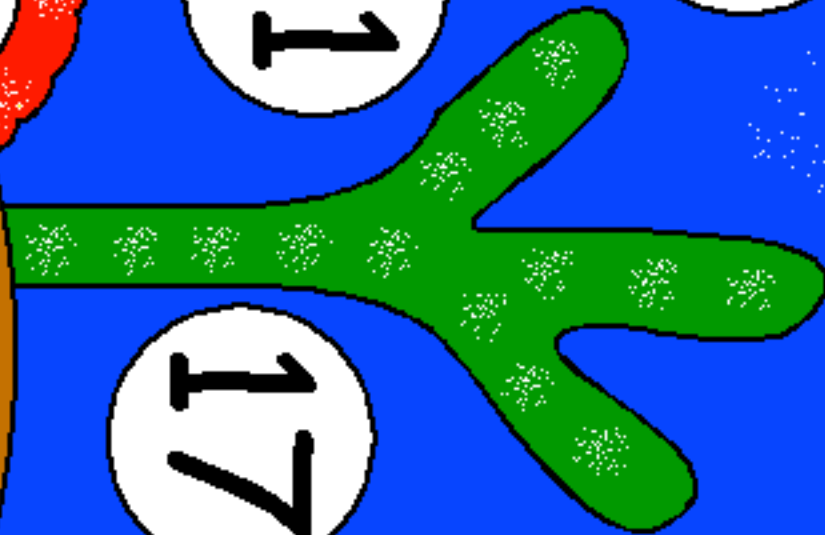


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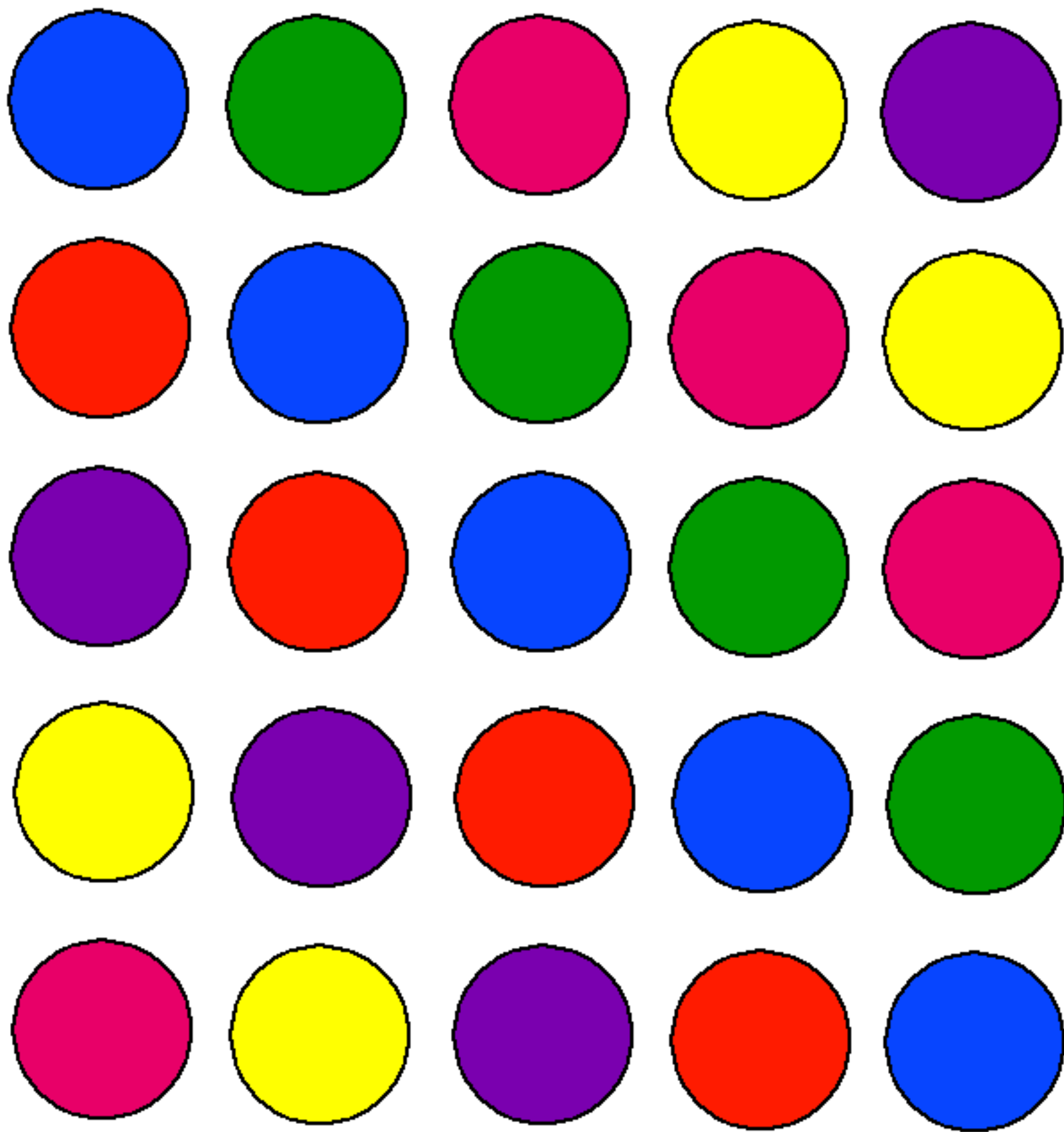
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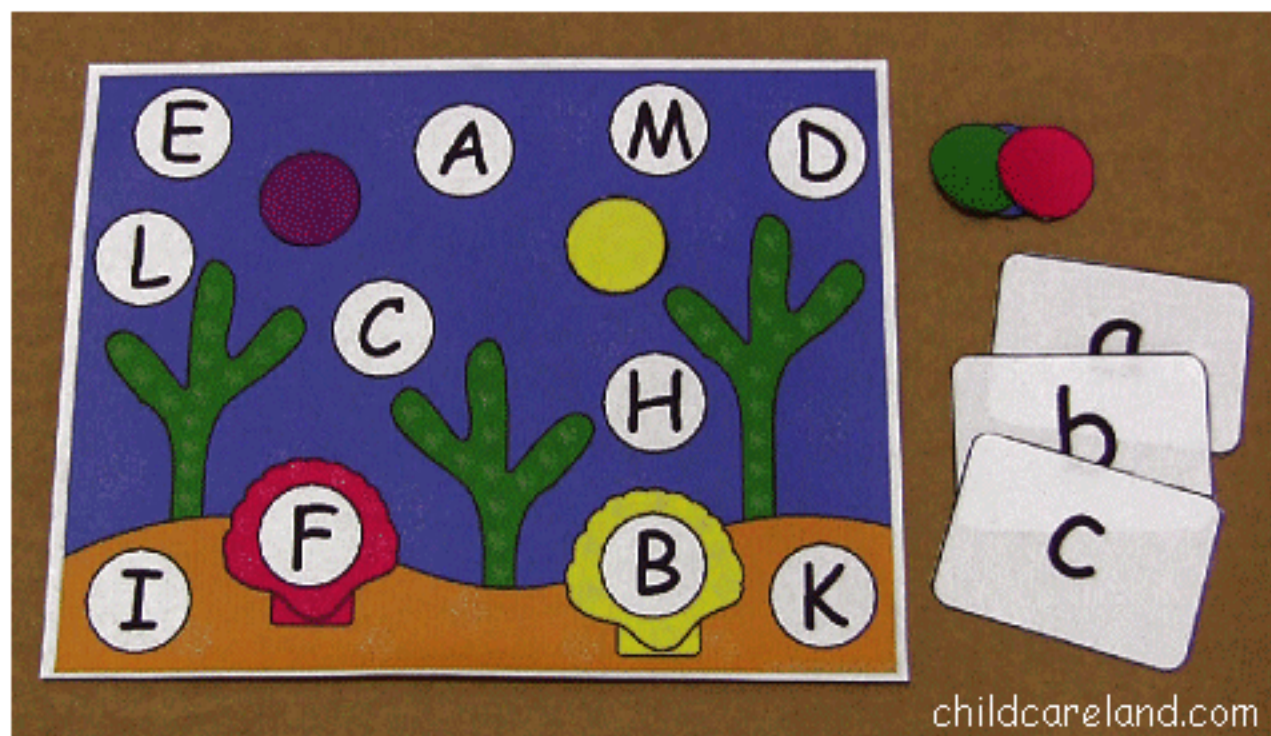
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Under The Sea Number Cover-Up



(shown with alphabet example)

Instructions: Print on cardstock paper ... cut out and laminate. This activity can be done as a teacher directed activity by the teacher calling out the numbers. For example the teacher would say "find and cover-up the number 2" and the child would find the number two on the number mat and cover it up with the provider marker. The teacher would continue until all of the numbers are covered up. To play as a child directed activity the child would put the number cards in a pile face down and draw a card. The child would use a marker to cover up the same number on the mat that was on the card.

This can also be used as a number identification evaluation tool by printing on regular paper. You can point to the numbers on the mat and or show the number cards and when the child identifies the number he/she can glue on one of the markers over the number identified. Write the date on and then repeat at a later time to see how the child has progressed.
